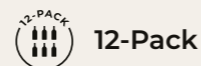
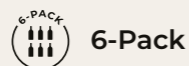

Tasting Notes

Enticing strawberry and cherry aromas intertwine with floral, herbaceous touches. The savoury, medium-bodied palate is ripe with strawberries and black cherry fruit. Soft toasted oak, powdery tannins, lingering finish.

Handpicked makes regionally expressive and site-specific wines in a growing list of the world's great wine regions. Their ethos has always been to share their love of wine with others, to demystify the world of wine and bring others on the journey, having lots of fun on the way. Handpicked Wines founder and managing director William Dong admits that he came into the wine industry knowing little about the challenges ahead; he just loved wine and wanted to make

wines that people would want to share together. It didn't take long to realise that to make truly great wines that express the best of their region he would need to invest in special vineyards and passionate people. Handpicked now own six vineyards in Mornington, Yarra Valley, Tasmania and Barossa Valley, and work with exceptional growers around the world who have become part of the Handpicked family over many years.

Tasting Notes

The Yarra Valley is known for refined, medium-weight Cabernets. This is a great example with flavours of black and red berries and plenty of fine tannin.

Haselgrove Switch GSM 2019

Established in 1981, Haselgrove is surrounded by over 10 hectares of Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Mataro vines – with the Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon vines dating back more than 60 years. They also work with a group of dedicated McLaren Vale and Adelaide Hills growers. Although renowned for producing rich and robust award winning reds from McLaren Vale, their whites are also making ripples with wine writers, and on the wine show circuit. Haselgrove has achieved a 5 red star rating by James Halliday and was

awarded the Dark Horse Winery of the Year in 2015. In more recent times, they were awarded the Winestate Magazine 2017 'Wine Company of the Year' and 2017 'Wine Maker of the Year'. In addition, they have accumulated numerous trophy's and gold medals on the national and international wine show circuit, including over 10 wines with a 90+ Halliday rating and 6 wines with a 90+ Parker rating. They are also very proud to be associated with Qantas and Korean Airlines where their wines are served to First and Business Class passengers.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of cherry, plum, aniseed and tobacco. Palate is spicy, notes of dried fruit, leather, red fruits with enduring length and power.

Terre a Terre Down to Earth Sauvignon Blanc 2022

Xavier and Lucy Bizot founded Terre a Terre in 2008, crafting classic Australian wines from their close-planted Crayères Vineyard in Wrattontully. Originally from Champagne, Xavier studied viticulture and winemaking at Adelaide University. After the vineyard was first planted in 2004, he introduced

what he had learned to try and produce the best fruit from this unique vineyard site. Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz is the signature red blend of Australia, and Terre à Terre have been crafting a very classic rendition of this iconic wine style.

Tasting Notes

Strong, well defined. Great fruit integration on the palate. Stone fruit, wet stone, touch of passionfruit, gooseberry. Great length. Very pleasant.

Eden Hall "Reserve" Riesling 2021

Compared to the Barossa floor, vineyard plantings were relatively sparse in the Eden Valley, scattered strategically amongst the rugged rocky outcrops and ancient majestic red gums. Eden Valley was already well recognised as a premium producer of Riesling, maintaining a healthy rivalry with the Clare Valley as the two most eminent Riesling producing regions in Australia. However, the Eden Valley was also developing a reputation that is now well established for cool

climate reds displaying finesse, elegance, and understated power. None of this was lost on David and Mardi Hall who could see that the Eden Valley high country offered the ideal environment to grow premium fruit and make wine in order to realise their dream. They were therefore very privileged to purchase the Avon Brae property in the Eden Valley in 1996, along with its historic homestead.

Tasting Notes

Pale straw with a floral nose dominated by jasmine and frangipani. Lemon from start to finish on the palate.

An austere, classical Eden Valley Riesling.

Fowles Small Batch Reserve Chardonnay 2021

Fowles Wine is a 100% family owned and operated winery located in the ancient granite landscape of the high altitude Strathbogie Ranges wine region in Victoria. Led by Matt Fowles, Fowles Wine crafts some of Australia's finest cool climate wines, winning many prestigious awards, including being a 5-star winery by James Halliday.

As a family of farmers, for generations they have been connected to the land; committed to ethical practices and simple approaches. Their approach to winemaking is fundamentally about capturing the essence of the Strathbogie Ranges. The special combination of climate, soil and topography is what gives their wines their structural core.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of orange and fragrant lemon, followed by apple, peach, hints of oak and dried coconut. The palate is silky and medium weight with a medley of stone fruit and citrus, and a hint of almond and lemon grass on the finish.
