Xavier and Lucy Bizot founded Terre a Terre in 2008, crafting classic Australian wines from their close-planted Crayères Vineyard in Wrattonbully. Originally from Champagne, Xavier studied viticulture and winemaking at Adelaide University. After the vineyard was first planted in 2004, he introduced

what he had learned to try and produce the best fruit from this unquie vineyard site. Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz is the signature red blend of Australia, and Terre à Terre have been crafting a very classic rendition of this iconic wine style.

Strong, well defined. Great fruit integration on the palate. Stone fruit, wet stone, touch of passionfruit, gooseberry. Great length. Very pleasant.

Eden Hall "Reserve" Riesling 2021

Compared to the Barossa floor, vineyard plantings were relatively sparse in the Eden Valley, scattered strategically amongst the rugged rocky outcrops and ancient majestic red gums. Eden Valley was already well recognised as a premium producer of Riesling, maintaining a healthy rivalry with the Clare Valley as the two most eminent Riesling producing regions in Australia. However, the Eden Valley was also developing a reputation that is now well established for cool

climate reds displaying finesse, elegance, and understated power. None of this was lost on David and Mardi Hall who could see that the Eden Valley high country offered the ideal environment to grow premium fruit and make wine in order to realise their dream. They were therefore very privileged to purchase the Avon Brae property in the Eden Valley in 1996, along with its historic homestead.

Pale straw with a floral nose dominated by jasmine and frangipani. Lemon from start to finish on the palate.

McWilliams have been the doyens of the Australian wine industry longer than anyone can remember. Their history now spans over six generations since venturing into wine in 1877. Today, they are one of the largest family owned wine businesses in the country. As well as having McWilliam's Mount Pleasant in the Hunter Valley, they also have the large Hanwood winery in the Riverina region of New South Wales that has existed since 1916. It is here wine ranges like Hanwood and Lillydale Estate are produced.

Recently, McWilliams ventured into the Margaret River after purchasing the Evans and Tate and Catching Thieves brands. Chief Winemaker Corey Ryan and Senior Winemaker Russell Cody dabble in regions around the country such as Coonawarra, Hilltops, Yarra Valley, Tumbarumba and Eden Valley. They produce quality wines ranging from reliable and affordable through to upmarket single vineyard. They also have some fun with fortifieds just to keep things interesting.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of apple, pear combined with fleshy stone fruits of peach and nectarine, along with classic mineral wet stone and flint, all backed up by spicy cedar oak nuances complemented with nutty almond and marzipan.
