The name 'Grounded Cru' epitomises Joffa's philosophies. 'Grounded' reflects his down to earth nature and the fact that he values relationships (collaborating with growers, etc) and pays attention to the little things; handcrafting his wines. It also carries a link to terroir and the vineyard. 'Cru' is a French

word meaning 'growth'. Joffa also likes to think of 'Cru' with regards to joining the crew or being part of a group of likeminded people. The Grounded Cru brand features handmade typography and a down to earth (grounded) Australian icon. We think this perfectly tells their unique story.

Tasting Notes

A complex nose showing vibrant red cherry and strawberry aromas with a hint of new French oak leads into a palate with classic Hills Pinot character. The distinctive influence of partial whole bunch ferment combines with bright red fruit goodness to bring this medium bodied drop to be enjoyed this summer!







Lifted nose, abundance of jasmine and orchard fruit, the palate continues with nashi pear and granny smith, very juicey style with a touch of minerality and phenolics giving some texture. Medium plus finish.

Credaro Kinship Chardonnay 2022

The Credaro family have a distinguished heritage in Western Australia as a pioneering family who settled in northern Margaret River in 1922. The family have now been commercially involved in the wine industry since the 1980's when their first plantings were established, supplying other established wineries. Robert and Phyllis Credaro, the 3rd generation of the family, created the Credaro wine brand

in 2009. They wanted to create more diversity to the estate, moving from farming and growing grapes to controlling the family's destiny by creating a long term future with a family wine brand. Today, the estate is managed by the third and fourth generations of the Credaro family. This encompasses 140 hectares of vines over seven separate vineyards across the Margaret River region.

Tasting Notes

The palate is medium-full bodied with stone fruit, white blossom, and zesty citrus flavours with creamy nougat characters from lees influence. Dense oak sweetness adds to the richness and length on the palate. Fine saline acidity gives the wine depth and length, finishing with rich white blossom and chewy oak
