Stonefields Reserve Wrattenbully Pinot Gris 2023

Being rated a 5 Red Star Winery by Halliday Wine Companion in 2022 Owner and vigneron Tim Davis works closely with winemaker Andrew Ling to create elegant and enjoyable wines in a range of styles - sparkling; dry whites, rosés and reds; dessert wines; and even fortifieds. They aim to make wines which express the varieties grown, the origins of the fruit, and the winemaking

techniques used to create a finished product. As a boutique producer of premium fruit from a range of climates, soil types and grape varieties, they quite literally have the first pick of fruit which goes into their wines. All vineyards are managed with a hands-on approach, often identifying individual rows or portions of rows to pick for small batches of wine.

Tasting Notes

Lifted nose, abundance of jasmine and orchard fruit, the palate continues with nashi pear and granny smith, very juicy style with a touch of minerality and phenolics giving some texture. Medium plus finish.

Credaro Kinship Chardonnay 2022

The Credaro family have a distinguished heritage in Western Australia as a pioneering family who settled in northern Margaret River in 1922. The family have now been commercially involved in the wine industry since the 1980's when their first plantings were established, supplying other established wineries. Robert and Phyllis Credaro, the 3rd generation of the family, created the Credaro wine brand

in 2009. They wanted to create more diversity to the estate, moving from farming and growing grapes to controlling the family's destiny by creating a long term future with a family wine brand. Today, the estate is managed by the third and fourth generations of the Credaro family. This encompasses 140 hectares of vines over seven separate vineyards across the Margaret River region.

Tasting Notes

The palate is medium-full bodied with stone fruit, white blossom, and zesty citrus flavours with creamy nougat characters from lees influence. Dense oak sweetness adds to the richness and length on the palate. Fine saline acidity gives the wine depth and length, finishing with rich white blossom and chewy oak.

Starting with four varieties, Catlin Wines has expanded its portfolio, sourcing grapes from premium vineyards in the Adelaide Hills and the Clare Valley, processing them gently in Nairne. Embracing wild ferments and minimal intervention, each wine is a true expression of its terroir, showcasing the best of individual, selected vineyards.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of freshly cut lemons and limes, on the palate the wine is fresh and focused, bright acidity with nashi pear and a spark of flint, medium bodied with a nutty finish.

Risky Business brings together the vision and decades of experience of grape grower/viticulturist Rob Quenby and vintner John Waldron. Together they have been sourcing fruit from Western Australia (primarily Margaret River) and Victoria's King Valley, producing small batches of fine and distinctive wines from each area. Rob Quenby, operator

of Quenby Viticultural Services (QVS) gives Risky Business opportunity to pre-select the best parcels from these great vineyards to use in their range. Their focus is controlling quality thru vineyard selection (often single vineyard) and sustainable vineyard management. Currently Risky Business produce wines with volumes ranging from 150 to 1,500 cases.

Tasting Notes

An off dry wine with mouth filling sweetness bursting with lemon, lime and apple blossom, balanced perfectly by bright acidity that finishes dry with great length.
