Laurent Perrachon Moulin à Vent «Terre Roses» 2021

The emblematic and historic family estate of Laurent Perrachon is one of the leading luminaries driving the reignition of the region and have been courted by some of the world's leading wine importers and wholesalers, particularly in the US and Europe. Using classic, goblet-trained, old-vine

material from some of the leading climates, Perrachon make dynamic, organic, terroir-driven wines that seem to have more in common with the great estates of Burgundy, than they do with Beaujolais itself. They are intensely cerebral wines that will have you coming back for more.

Tasting Notes

It is a well built wine which has a dark ruby rim. The bouquet is dominated by iris, wilted rose, spices and ripe fruit aromas. Moulin a Vent is a wine to age, classified as the 'Lord of the Beaujolais' wines.

Heirloom Vinevards Velvet Fog Pinot Noir 2021

Heirloom Vineyards was conceived in vintage 2000, when a young winemaking student caught the eye of a wine judge. A love story ensued inspired by two vows: To preserve the best of tradition, the old world of wine and our unique old vineyards and to champion the best clones of each

variety planted in the most appropriate sites embracing the principals of organic and biodynamic farming. Seven long vintages of trial and error passed before Heirloom Vineyards could make a wine that was fine enough to pass on to future generations. This is that wine.

Tasting Notes

Fresh and lively Pinot aromas combine with restrained French oak. Notes of black fruits and berries with a powerful, linear acidity that balances the fruit exceptionally. Tannins dry out the finish yet generosity lingers.

Devitt & Moore William Pile Barossa Shiraz 2018

Devitt & Moore Wines is a celebration and acknowledgment of the innovation and craftsmanship of Captain D. Bruce, who designed the luxury clipper ship, 'The City of Adelaide,' built

by Pile and Co. for shop owners Devitt and Moore, in 1863. Around 240,000 descendants of her passengers are living in Australia today.

Tasting Notes

Full-bodied and rich, this Barossa Shiraz displays notes of aromatic black fruit concentrate and touches of subtle oak. With fine tannins that support the palate for a complex finish and lasting impression.

The Château Bonnet estate covers 20 hectares of vines in the best part of the area such as Chenas, Moulin-à-Vent, Juliénas, Saint-Amour and Beaujolais Villages (white, rosé and red). Beaujolais Crus of Château Bonnet are well known and awarded in France but also at international competitions. Château Bonnet is committed to produce their wines in a sustainable, responsible and ecologic way. So on each bottle, you will find the "Terra Vitis" logo which proves this commitment.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of strawberry jam, raspberry, and eucalyptus. The palate has black-fruit flavours, supported by spice and minerality completed by fruity polished tannin.

Terre à Terre Crayeres **Vineyard Cabernet Franc Shiraz 2018**

Xavier and Lucy Bizot founded Terre à Terre in 2008, crafting classic Australian wines from their close planted Crayères Vineyard in Wrattonbully. Xavier is originally from Champagne, and studied viticulture and winemaking at Adelaide University. After the vineyard was first planted in

2004, he introduced what he had learned to try and produce the best fruit from this unque vineyard site. Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz is the signature red blend of Australia, and Terre à Terre have been crafting a very classic rendition of this iconic wine style.

Tasting Notes

A charming and seductive wine with unique floral characters, ripe blackberry fruit on the mid palate with a leafy, medicinal touch and an interesting malty oak character.
