## Barry Family Vineyards Clare Valley Riesling 2021



Jim Barry Wines is a family winery based in the Clare Valley of South Australia. The company was founded in 1959 by Jim and Nancy Barry. The company is now owned and managed by Peter Barry, a second generation family winemaker. Jim Barry

Wines is home to some of Australia's favourite wines such as The Armagh, The McRae Wood, The Benbournie, First Eleven, Pb, The Cover Drive, The Lodge Hill Shiraz, The Barry Brothers, The Florita, The Lodge Hill Riesling and Watervale Riesling.

### Tasting Notes

Framed with zippy grapefruit, the nose of the wine is bursting with lime leaf, citrus rind and yellow melons. On the palate, it exhibits classic Clare flavours, including white stone fruit, lime juice, lemon verbena, and old-fashioned lemonade. It has a plush line throughout with plenty of length and girth.

## Dopff & Irion Riesling Cuvée René Dopff 2019



Dopff & Irion was created in 1945, so just after the Second World War, by the merger of two wine families: the Dopff family and the Irion family. René Dopff was the son of Jean Gustave Dopff, winemaker in Riquewihr and whose family produces wines since the 16th century. He took care of the management and administration and his brother

Julien worked mainly in the vineyards. Following a dispute between the two brothers, René left the winery and joined the Resistance. On his return to Riquewihr in March 45, René goes into partnership with Jeanne Irion, a major family name in the Alsatian vineyard, to create the company Dopff & Irion.

### Tasting Notes

Fresh green and red apple notes on both the nose and palate are followed by a dry and fresh finish.

## Tascante Buonora Etna Bianco 2020



Nerello Mascalese is the hero in this part of the world, a dark skinned grape that produces taut and mineral wines with a herbal edge that have an aromatic profile that has been likened to a mixture of Burgundy and Barolo. Nerello Cappuccino, another endemic variety, is often added to the

classic Etna blend (Etna Rosso) to lift the perfume. In the white camp the key variety here is Carricante, known for it's high acidity, broad spectrum of citrus flavours (think lemon to grapefruit to tangerine and back again) and ageability, but Chardonnay is also produced.

### Tasting Notes

A bright, pretty white with crushed lemon-rind, green-apple, almond and lemon aromas and flavors. It's medium-bodied with attractive fruit and a long, lively finish. Drink now.

## Credaro Family Wines Sauvignon Blanc 2021



The Credaro family have a distinguished heritage in Western Australia as a pioneering family who settled in northern Margaret River in 1922. The family had humble beginnings within the agriculture and timber industries, building bridges for the first railways and major roads in the region. Cesar Credaro left Northern Italy for a new start in 1921 and met his brother Olympio at Fremantle Port after a three month voyage. The family have now been commercially involved in

the wine industry since the 1980's when their first plantings were established, supplying other established wineries. Robert and Phyllis Credaro, the 3rd generation of the family, created the Credaro wine brand in 2009. They wanted to create more diversity to the estate, moving from farming and growing grapes to controlling the family's destiny by creating a long term future with a family wine brand.

### Tasting Notes

Summery tropical fruit notes dominate the vibrant and intriguing aroma, that feels very inviting. Bright minerality greets you immediately on the pallet, with fresh tropical fruit and lime juice characters flowing through behind a firm acid backbone.
