Baileys of Glenrowan Organic Durif 2019



The Baileys of Glenrowan winery has a very long and cherished history, with the Bailey family first establishing the winery in 1870. This timeline was written with assistance of Vicki Bailey, the Great Grand-daughter of Varley Bailey.

Tasting Notes

Nose is ripe red and blue fruits - raspberry, mulberry, blueberry and more with complex notes of licorice, aniseed, cacao and malt in the background. Palaye is medium to full bodied with silky tannins making equally suitable to early consumption or place in the cellar for a future special occasion

Spinifex Garçon Grenache 2020



Spinifex was started in 2001 with the opportunity to source some great old vine Mataro growing in deep white drift-sand on the Barossa Valleys' Western Ridge. Owned by husband and wife team, Peter Schell and Magali Gely, their focus is on regional wines from the traditional Mediterranean grape varieties that have been grown successfully in Australia for over 150 years - Shiraz, Mataro, Grenache, Cinsault, Carignan, Ugni Blanc, Grenache Gris, Marsanne and Semillon. They aim

to make wines that display signatures of vineyard provenance and vintage, show regional typicity and have a consistent thread of 'house style' that reflects their preferences and experiences with wine. The wines they choose to make are predominately blends, the synergies derived from blending wines of differing character enhance the subtle complexities, even textures and profound personalities delivered from great old vine vineyards.

Tasting Notes

This Cabernet Sauvignon is full of flavour, texture and complexity. The fruit is voluptuous and full with blackberry coco, ripe red jalapeno, plum and black olive characters, finishing with a fine bead of tannin and power enhanced by quality integrated oak. A varietal perfect wine.

Wildside Pinot Noir 2019

Headed by Liam McElhinney, who has produced some of NZ's most iconic wines (including The Ned & Saint Clair), alongside the over-achieving Julian Langworthy of Deep Woods (winner of the Jimmy Watson, and James Halliday Winemaker of the Year in 2020), the Wildside Pinot is Tasmanian magic in a bottle. We

were lucky enough to snag a barrel or two of the incredible juice this pair had weaved together in 2019, and have bottled it under our celebrated Wildside label. While we can't tell you the exact origins of this wine, we can say the Wildside is every bit as good as the famous hands who helped bring it together.

Tasting Notes

Bright, intense fruit. Red berries, cherries and nice savoury elements. Silky tannins and elegant oak treatment. As good as Tassie Pinot gets at the price-point.

Deep Woods Redlands Cabernet Sauvignon 2019

Deep Woods Estate was founded in the northern end of the beautiful Margaret River region of W.A in 1987. It changed hands in 1992 when the Gould family purchased the winery, and was sold again in 2005. Today, it is part of the Fogarty Wine Group (they also own Lakes Folly, Millbrook and Smithbrook wines). The property nests on a ridge overlooking a sea of Jarrah and Marri trees, hence the name Deep Woods. It boasts 16 hectares

of sustainably-managed, low-yielding vineyards segregated into 12 blocks planted to Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc, Verdelho, Chardonnay, Merlot, Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. Winemaker Julian Langworthy employs traditional and state-of-the-art techniques to craft small batches of wines of impeccable quality under several different labels.

Tasting Notes

Lovely bright colour the aromas leap from the glass in a vivid spectrum of crunchy red fruits and subtle spiciness. The Palate is fine and medium bodied with the silkiest of tannins.



School House Headmaster Shiraz 2019



Set in a former limestone quarry, the sheer walls, show to perfection the signature white limestone topped by dramatic red terra rossa soil the region is famous for. The physical attributes of this setting are utilised, allowing gravity to ensure that fruit is handled as gently as possible. The state of the art equipment allows great flexibility in the handling, including whole fruit pressing, full/partial destemming, designed to maximise the potential of any fruit.

Tasting Notes

Vibrant and intense black cherry and forest berries, balanced with liquorice, spice and earthy notes. Generous red fruits are supported by fine boned tannins and underlying oak complexity, delivering a cool-climate Shiraz at its best.
