Dopff & Irion was created in 1945, so just after the Second World War, by the merger of two wine families: the Dopff family and the Irion family. René Dopff was the son of Jean

Gustave Dopff, winemaker in Riquewihr and whose family produces wines since the 16th century.



Tasting Notes

Fresh green and red apple notes on both the nose and palate are followed by a dry and fresh finish.

Oakridge Yarra Valley Chardonnay 2018

Oakridge was first setup in 1978 as what was originally a family company. By the turn of the century the label was gobbled up by a large Australian wine company (where it flailed) until being taken back into family hands with the talented David Bicknell on winemaking duties in 2002.

Since then Oakridge - and David Bicknell - has garnered a

reputation as one of our finest Chardonnay makers, with a particularly handy Pinot and Shiraz or two also in the Oakridge portfolio Oakridge is all about the Yarra Valley, and particularly the Upper Yarra where it sources much of its fruit from.



Tasting Notes

Aromas of white citrus blossom, white stone fruit and grapefruit, with flecks of gunflint, and hints of fresh nuts, almond meal, and white peach skin. The palate is poised with a lovely shape. The bright acid line running through keeps everything in its place and providing drive and length.

Millbrook Regional Vermentino 2021

The fruit was hand-picked in the cool of the early morning for processing. Fruit was then destemmed, crushed and gently pressed to allow for extraction of clear, free run juice. This clean, clear juice was racked from the solids and fermented

with a specifically chosen yeast strain at cool temperatures to retain the subtle aromatics of this wine. Lightly fined and filtered for clarity before being bottled in May 2021.

Tasting Notes

Zesty citrus, white blossom and mineral, elegant in its subtlety. A clean, beautifully dry and textured palate of crunchy green apple and citrus. Fine, limey acidity and savoury spice add to a delightful wine, perfect with a wide range of cuisines.

Peter Lehmann H&V Pinot Gris 2019

In 1979 Peter Lehmann parted ways with Saltram to start Masterson Wines, the company which has since evolved into Peter Lehmann Wines, in a move solely designed to help the growers he had built relationships with over the years. Peter took the surplus grapes and doing business on a handshake

sold wine on a "pay now and we'll deliver in two years" arrangement called 'The Futures'. This raised enough money to buy the growers' fruit and process it into what became the first ever vintage of Peter Lehmann wine in 1980.

Tasting Notes

Lifted nashi pear and juicy peaches. Soft and abundant in melon fruits with a crisp red apple finish.

Domaine Baud L'Etoile Chardonnay 2016

To the eye, it has a light yellow color with green reflects. To the nose aroma of nuts dominate. To the palate, it is greedy and round. It is well balanced with an astonishing long lasting taste.
