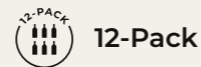
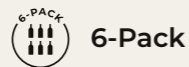

Terre Del Barolo Organic Nebbiolo d'Alba 2019

One of the marvels of this region is the "Terre del Barolo" winery in Castiglione Falletto, established amidst the vineyards that grow one of the world's most illustrious wines: Barolo. A family of smallholders – because that is what each of its three hundred members has remained – living,

farming and nourishing the land, while adding value to their enterprise with their own culture, history and customs. Every cluster tells the story of the miracle of the seasons, of the sun and the rain, of work that encompasses thousands of nuances.

Tasting Notes

Ruby red in colour with spicy fruit aromas and a dry, harmonious palate. This wine is elegant and well-structured with excellent length.

Tasting Notes

Layers of plum, blackberry and hints of dark chocolate make the palate complex yet refined. Dark fruit and graphite linger in the mouth with supple tannins providing pleasing length and a dry finish.

Peos Estate Four Kings Cabernet Sauvignon 2018

Manjimup has been home to the Macedonian-born Peos family for more than 90 years. With viticulture in their historical veins, brothers Vic, John, Kon and Chris banded together in 1996 to create their dream vineyard as a legacy to their late father, Jim Peos, and late grandfather, P.Y. Peos. A passionate farmer, P.Y. began cultivating grapes and producing wine whilst living in Macedonia almost a century ago. He passed this love of wine down to his son, Jim, who continued to farm grapes and make wine in Macedonia until he joined P.Y. and the rest of his family in Australia in

1951. Upon first arriving in Australia the Peos family settled in Manjimup, attracted by its rich soils and ideal crop-growing weather. Their undying devotion to living off the land has seen them farm everything from dairy cattle and beef to mixed horticulture, potatoes, cauliflowers and beans.

The establishment of Peos Estate winery by the third generation Peos brothers has turned the family dynasty full-circle back to where it belongs, growing grapes and producing wine to remember.

Tasting Notes

Medium bodied with a generous mouth-feel, well balanced acidity and fine dusty tannins. Flavours of cigar, black forest, eggnog and vanilla.

Glenlofty Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2017

Glenlofty Estate's vineyards sprawl across the foothills of the Pyrenees appellation in Western Victoria. Here the climate, ancient granitic soil types and varying slopes mirror those of France's northern Rhône region.

Glenlofty is best-known for its Shiraz and Roussanne/Marsanne, which combine intensity with elegance in a way that's totally unlike the wines of Australia's warmer regions like Barossa or the Hunter Valley.

Tasting Notes

Aromas and flavours of blackberry jam, dark chocolate cookies, croissant, a hint of mint, and black tea. The palate is chewy and fruity with ample body, firm tannins and a moderate oak influence.
