Located in Coonawarra, at the heart of South Australia's Limestone Coast, Coonawarra Wines is a modern, efficient winery, capable of crafting unique parcels of high quality wine. The winery is family owned is operated by a dedicated and experienced team. We have a reputation for exceptional quality and have supplied wine to some of Australia's best known wineries. Set in a former limestone quarry, the sheer walls, show to perfection the signature white limestone topped by dramatic red terra rossa soil the region is famous for. The physical attributes of this setting are utilised, allowing gravity to ensure that fruit is handled as gently as possible. The state of the art equipment allows great flexibility in the handling, including whole fruit pressing, full/partial destemming, designed to maximise the potential of any fruit.

Tasting Notes

Fragrant lemon and lime, intense white peach and stone fruits with gentle hints of wild flowers. Fresh fleshy passionfruit, nectarine and citrus notes are complimented by textured and subtle fruity acid and a crisp dry finish.

Hewitson Gun Metal Riesling 2022

Established in 1998 Hewitson winery is situated in the heart of the Barossa Valley on the historic Seppeltsfield Road and boasts some of the oldest vines in the world. Our fruit is sourced from historic, dry-grown vineyards in the Barossa Valley and also from single site vineyards in Eden Valley,

McLaren Vale and the Adelaide Hills.

While Hewitson's vineyards are spread throughout the renowned wine regions of South Australia, the heart of their winemaking is always within the Barossa, as all of their wine comes from their Seppeltsfield Road facilities.

Tasting Notes

Pale straw with green tinges. Lime dominates the flavour profile while carrying the trademark Gun Metal minerality. The palate is delicate, refined and intense, with a firm, dry finish and lingering aftertaste.

Established by the Smedley family, Mandala Wines is a five-star James Halliday-rated Yarra Valley winery. The main site and Cellar Door at Dixon's Creek offers a full range of prized Estate wines for tasting, along with its renowned assortment of single-site wines. It was the family's favourite wines which lead them to the Yarra Valley region; Charles' love of Pinot Noir

and Chardonnay plus the region's famous sublime cool climate Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, made it the perfect choice. But Mandala have also established Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, Sauvignon Blanc and Merlot vines too. With their sites only an hour from Melbourne, it really was the best place to unearth Mandala and make the wines they love to drink.

Tasting Notes

A bright aromatic profile of mandarin, citrus blossom, and stone-fruit, combines with subtle hints of peanut husk and brioche. A generous and textural mid palate is supported by subtly integrated oak and lively acidity.

Chateau du Trignon Cotes du Rhone Roussanne 2021

The Roux Family acquired the Château du Trignon in 1896. Back then it was a traditional Provençal farm of the time, with mixed and livestock farming. Since then 5 generations have refocused the farm on the vine and expanded the estate; a

qualitative approach is also underway. In 2006, the family Quiot charmed by the Dentelles de Montmirail, wish to perpetuate Château du Trignon.

Tasting Notes

Straw yellow colour. Apricot, may blossom, honey and elegant smell of Narcissus notes. Rich mid palate, showing a slight custard character.

Gaelic Cemetery McAskill Riesling 2022

The Credaro family have a distinguished heritage in Western Australia as a pioneering family who settled in northern Margaret River in 1922. The family had humble beginnings within the agriculture and timber industries, building bridges for the first railways and major roads in the region. Cesar Credaro left Northern Italy for a new start in 1921 and met his brother Olympio at Fremantle Port after a three month voyage. The family have now been commercially involved in

the wine industry since the 1980's when their first plantings were established, supplying other established wineries.

Robert and Phyllis Credaro, the 3rd generation of the family, created the Credaro wine brand in 2009. They wanted to create more diversity to the estate, moving from farming and growing grapes to controlling the family's destiny by creating a long term future with a family wine brand.

Tasting Notes

Brilliant pale straw with green hues. Aromas of lemongrass, citrus and hints of jasmine. The palate is defined by the drive and structure of the natural, mouth coating acidity with flavours of lemon sorbet and kaffir lime.

Tascante Buonora Etna Bianco 2020

Grown on the volcanic soils of Europe's highest mountain, winemakers experiment with the differing altitudes to craft wines of stunning minerality and focus. These wines are the darling of the professional wine drinker's world right now - after the dominance of Chianti and then Piedmonte over the last several decades it seems like it is finally time for

the spotlight to shine on Sicily. Tascante is the estate we're visiting today, a subsidiary of mother estate Tenuta Regaleali. As eighth generation winemakers, with holdings all over the island, you can be sure they've got that true Sicilian flavour running through their blood.

Tasting Notes

A bright, pretty white with crushed lemon-rind, green-apple, almond and lemon aromas and flavors. It's medium-bodied with attractive fruit and a long, lively finish. Drink now.
