## Watkins Sibling Series Langhorne Creek Grenache 2022



The Watkins family entered the wine industry in 1997 when David and Ros Watkins planted their first vineyard in South Australia. In 2019, David and Ros brought their children into the fold: Sam Watkins as Winemaking Director, Ben Watkins at Commercial Director and Jo Watkins as Export, Sales and Marketing Director. Together the Watkins family own and operate a winery and vineyard (8ha) in Clarendon, Adelaide Hills and a vineyard in Langhorne Creek (141ha). There was an opportunity to start selling their premium wine from these vineyards directly to consumers, which saw the start of the Watkins label. Sam Watkins, as the winemaker, has spent over 15 years training and refining his palate. Sam has undertaken vintages in well-known wine regions across the world including the Napa Valley in the USA and the Duoro Valley in Portugal.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Elegantly perfumed with dark cherry, violet, olive and subtle spice aromas, followed by a juicy palate delivering fleshy texture and fine, mellow tannins. Silky and flowing to a lengthy velvety finish.

## Idle Hill Shiraz 2021

One of the largest landholders in the Barossa, Grant Burge wines is a bastion of well made, value for money wines. Drawing on their depth of experience in the region, Grant Burge and his wife Helen established the brand in 1988 and have developed a formidable range of wines across a broad spectrum of price points. The history of the Burge family and their long association with winemaking in the region can be traced back to March 1855, when noted tailor John Burge immigrated to the Barossa from Hillcot, near Pewsey in Wiltshire, England with his wife Eliza and their two sons.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Oak is immediately present on the nose. Rounded vanillan oak characters continue on the palate, harmonising with pleasant charry tannins, savoury leather notes and red fruit characters.

## Reschke R Series Malbec 2022

The Reschke family first settled in Coonawarra in 1906, where they established their Hereford stud. The cattle grazing heritage is the inspiration for the Bull logo and hopefully symbolises their 'grit' in pursuit of their goals, passion, strength and resolve. The Reschke vineyard holdings of 400 acres, consists of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Shiraz, Petit Verdot, all cropped particularly low to yield the highest quality fruit. The generation of Coonawarra that Reschke represents is two fold, with cutting edge viticulture married to traditional wine making techniques under the watchful eye of winemaking legend, Peter Douglas.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Aromas of violet perfume with complex rich red black fruit flavours. Enhanced with fragrant spice and oak, the medium bodied wine is a complex easy drinking style that is ready for immediate enjoyment.

## **Grandeur Wellington Artisan** Mclaren Vale Shiraz 2015

In the early 1800s, Napoleon's France seemed poised to rule the world. However, in 1815 history turned. Combined armies lead by the cool head and superior tactics of Arthur Wellesley, 1st Duke of Wellington, defeated Napoleon's forces at the famed Battle of Waterloo. Wellington's victory helped usher in a new era of peace, prosperity and progress across Europe. As the years progressed, Wellington's considerable influence as a statesman helped the South Australian Colonisation Bill through the British Parliament – ultimately leading to the first vines being planted in the fledgling colony of South Australia at McLaren Vale in 1838.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Complex nose, with well-integrated oak softening the natural fruit and tannins. The full-bodied palate features notes of mocha, chocolate, liquorice and blueberry leading into a long, luscious mouthfeel.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Dark plum, layers of red fruits, combining with subtle hints of spice, opulent liquorice and minerality. Medium bodied with a balanced acidity, well rounded yet relatively soft mouthfeel.
