Tertini Pinot Blanc 2021

When Julian Tertini began the development of Tertini Wines in 2000, he followed in the footsteps of Joseph Vogt 145 years earlier. History does not relate the degree of success that Joseph had, but the site he chose then was, as it is now, a good one. Tertini has Pinot Noir and Riesling (1.8ha each), Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay (1ha each), Arneis (0.9ha), Pinot Gris (0.8ha), Merlot (0.4ha) and Lagrein (0.2ha). Winemaker Jonathan Holgate, who is responsible for the outstanding results achieved at Tertini, presides over High Range Vintners, a contract winemaking business also owned by Julian Tertini.

Tasting Notes

Citrus and green apple dominate the aromas with subtle chalkiness. These characters flow onto the palate with a fine texture contributed from its 5 months maturing on lees. Crisp acidity gives it length and liveliness.

The Brand family legacy dates back to 1852, stretching over six generations. Today, Brand & Sons is owned and managed by fourth generation vigneron Sam Brand, producing boutique wine using high quality products from select vineyard sites across South Australia.

Tasting Notes

Elegant nose of crunchy apple, grapefruit, nougat and roasted cashew, leading to a creamy, textured palate of juicy fruit flavours, backed by bright acidity. Delightfully restrained and harmonious with a long linear finish.

Much of Australia's premier wine-growing regions were profoundly influenced by volcanic activity of many millennia ago. "Chain of Fire" is the experts' term for a series of extinct volcanoes. Rich volcanic soils create ideal conditions for the growth of high quality grapes which we celebrate in this label featuring a blacksmith - in tribute to Vulcan, the Roman God of Volcanoes, a supremely skilled artisan whose metal-working forge was a volcano.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of white nectarine, peach, and a subtle smokey toastiness. A rich and complex fruit-driven wine with gentle oak influence and fresh acidity.

CW Winemaker Series Pinot Grigio 2021

Located in Coonawarra, at the heart of South Australia's Limestone Coast, Coonawarra Wines is a modern, efficient winery, capable of crafting unique parcels of high quality wine. The winery is family owned is operated by a dedicated and experienced team. They have a reputation for exceptional quality and have supplied wine to some of Australia's best known wineries. Wines that they have produced for clients have won many awards both locally and internationally. Set in a former limestone quarry, the sheer walls show to perfection the signature white limestone topped by dramatic red terra rossa soil for which the region is famous. The physical attributes of this setting are utilised, allowing gravity to ensure that fruit is handled as gently as possible. The state of the art equipment allows great flexibility in the handling, including whole fruit pressing and full/partial destemming, designed to maximise the potential of any fruit.

Tasting Notes

Perfumed and lifted aromas of vibrant pear, apple and peach. The rounded palate is crisp and fresh and lingers with complex fresh fruit flavours.

Andrew Peace Winemaker's Choice Riesling 2014



Through three generations of Peace family labour, the 'country retreat' vineyard produced its first vintage in 1995 and a commercial winery was born. Every vintage since has accompanied another chapter of family life – celebrations, milestones and happy memories. Nurtured from the rich Murray River bank soil, the vineyard was established in the 1960's. From a humble beginning in 1995 with a grape intake of 1711 tonnes, Andrew Peace Wines has grown to be one of Australia's largest family owned wineries, crushing over 43,000 tonnes per year. The winery is utterly contemporary, driven with sound business acumen and utilising first class technology.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of kerosene, citrus, dried apricot, peach and a touch of honey blossom. These characters continue nicely on the textured palate, with a softened, well-integrated acidity, leading to a rich and moreish finish.

Norfolk Rise Coast is Clear Pinot Gris 2022

Norfolk Rise is the best-kept secret of South Australia, with the vineyard in Mount Benson only planted in 2000, and the first vintage off the estate bottled in 2002. From a most underrated region that offers a unique combination of free-draining limestone soil profiles and cool maritime breezes that produce wines of exceptional quality and complexity. If the region was perhaps less remote, you'd imagine it could be a superstar, and Norfolk Rise would be the headliner.

Tasting Notes

A Pinot Gris that is rich and rounded. Ripe pear and a touch of spice on the nose, carry through to a bright and finely balanced palate. The mouthfeel is soft yet refined with a well balanced crisp finish.
