Long Gully Shiraz 2020



In 1972 Reiner Klapp, founder of Klapp Electronics, and his wife Irma purchased their 40-hectare weekend retreat in the picturesque foothills of the Great Dividing Range on Long Gully Road just west of Healesville. Little did they know then that this decision would become the beginning of a whole new life for them and they certainly had no idea that they would go on to become major contributors to the rebirth of the wine industry in the Yarra Valley. Long Gully Estate has grown to become one of the larger 'boutique vineyards' in the Yarra Valley, building their own on-site winemaking facility and crushing around 100 tons of grapes every vintage. The winery has received numerous awards and accolades for their exceptional wines, winning nine prestigious trophies and a tally of gold, silver and bronze medals numbering in the hundreds.

Tasting Notes

Deep vibrant purple. Luscious bouquet full of boysenberry, black pepper & liquorice. The wine is medium bodied with a palate showing ripe black, plum fruits tamed by black pepper spices balanced on a long, rich and complex palate.

Busselton Boys Cabernet Merlot 2019

In 1830 three brothers - Alfie, Charlie and Jack Bussell - disembarked in the hot sun after a long and arduous sea voyage on the 'Warrior' at the infant Swan River Colony, Western Australia. After a few unsuccessful years attempting to earn their fortune around Augusta, this enterprising trio set off into the wilderness in search of a better place to establish a farm. They eventually found a favourable site with good soil and mild conditions, and here their farm - and the brothers - prospered. This small pioneering plot was the beginnings of what would eventually grow into the thriving Margaret River settlement of Busselton. The boys' endearing sense of adventure lives on in Margaret River with its contemporary winemaking style. Each of The Busselton Boys wines, made by awardwinning winemaker Paul Boulden, captures both the intriguing characters of their namesakes, and of the region.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of sweet spice and dark berries. Juicy plum and sweet spice with a smoky finish.

Graphite Road Estate in Manjimup sources fruit from a selection of vineyards throughout the picturesque southwest corner of Western Australia. Their Cross Sections wines encompass the region's diversity - the rolling hills and lush farmlands of the Great Southern, the endless coastline framing Margaret River and the towering Karri tree forests.

Tasting Notes

Bright ruby red in colour. Aromas of rhubarb, red berries and herbal notes. Red fruits, tobacco box with an herbal finish on the palate.

Idle Hill Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

One of the largest landholders in the Barossa, Grant Burge wines is a bastion of well-made, value for money wines. Drawing on depth of experience in the region, Grant Burge and his wife Helen established the brand in 1988 and have developed a formidable range of wines across a broad spectrum of price points. The history of the Burge family and their long association with winemaking in the region can be traced back to March 1855, when noted tailor John Burge immigrated to the Barossa from Hillcot, near Pewsey in Wiltshire, England with his wife Eliza and their two sons.

Tasting Notes

Deep red in colour, with classic Cabernet characters of cassis and blackberry, finishing with fine, silky tannins.

Devitt & Moore Sunderland Shiraz 2020



Devitt & Moore Wines is a celebration and acknowledgment of the innovation and craftsmanship of Captain D. Bruce, who designed the luxury clipper ship, 'The City of Adelaide,' built by Pile and Co. for shop owners Devitt and Moore, in 1863. Around 240,000 descendants of her passengers are living in Australia today.

Tasting Notes

This Shiraz delivers rich notes of dark-bodied fruits along with aromatic red-berry concentrates. With hints of subtle oak and touches of spicy pepper notes to complete the palate, allowing for instant enjoyment.

Bannockburn 1314 a.d. Shiraz 2014



Stuart Hooper was a successful businessman with a passion for everything about wine. He envisioned creating a vineyard that would produce Australian wine of a quality that emulates the great regions of France. In the early 1970's Stuart selected a plot of land in the Moorabool Valley near the township of Bannockburn. A promising site with the desirable soil composition consistent with quality viticulture and a rich history of premium wine grape production dating back to the 1870's. The initial plantings were Shiraz vines. Before long, more land was acquired, more vines and varieties planted - the story had begun. A major contribution to the success of Bannockburn Vineyards was the strong foundation Stuart provided through his purist, uncompromising approach when he established the vineyard and winery.

Tasting Notes

Bright red fruits and lifted pepper are at the core of this Shiraz, with fine tannin in support and a walloping one-two punch of spice-flecked berries, charcuterie and dried flowers.
