Tasting Notes

Bright and magenta in colour. Aromas of ripe raspberry and plum fruits with floral notes. Bursting from the glass with continued ripe raspberry and plum fruits, hints of white pepper and spicy cloves for an earthy finish.

Spanning Orange and Central Ranges, it features diverse elevations and volcanic soils, benefiting from high altitude, intense sunlight, and a cool climate. Led by Group Chief Winemaker Rod Hooper and Debbie Lauritz, the winemaking team meticulously crafts wines known for bright fruit flavors and subtle elegance. Sourcing premium grapes from renowned regions like Orange, Clare Valley, and Margaret River, Cumulus Wines showcases a comprehensive array of Australia's distinguished wine regions. Their commitment to cultivating long-term relationships with premium grape growers ensures consistent access to top-quality fruit, reflecting their dedication to crafting exceptional wines capturing the essence of Australia's diverse landscapes.

Tasting Notes

Wild strawberries and spice on the palate. The palate continues with red and black berries, dried herbs looking like sage and thyme, and oak spice in the form of anise, tobacco and cedar. Very enjoyable.

Blind Corner, conceived by Ben & Naomi Gould in 2007, is the fruit of a journey that began in a rustic red builder's van, traversing the surf breaks and wine regions of Western Europe. Upon their return in 2009, Ben and Naomi poured their passion and experience into their modest 4Ha vineyard, crafting wild wines with a hands-on approach. Now a 20Ha vineyard certified in Organic and Biodynamic practices, Blind Corner embraces natural methods with transparency and minimal intervention. Their wines, including Pétnat, Shiraz, Fortified, and Qvevri, are made 'sans soufre' (with nothing added), embodying pure natural winemaking. Beyond unique wines, Blind Corner pioneers regenerative farming and true natural winemaking in Australia. It's not just a winery; it's Ben and Naomi's vision, a blend of love for the land, surf, and the art of natural winemaking.

Tasting Notes

It has a deep ruby colour with hints of purple. Aromas of dark cherry and plums are met with subtle notes of pepper, cinnamon and cloves. The palate is full-bodied and juicy with a pleasant balance between sweet and savoury. The tannins are smooth and gentle, with a long, lingering finish.

Tasting Notes

A pleasing nose of nettles, green apple and limes. This wine has a pale lemon-green hue, with its crisp and zesty palate packed with lemon, green apple and freshly cut grass flavours. Its mouthfeel is full-bodied yet delicate, with a balanced acidity and a long, lingering finish.

Rolled oats, cereal and malt aromas, on the palate the wine is rich and full bodied, creamy and mouth filling style, notes of peach curd, porridge, almond meal, baby corn, cinnamon, clove, nutmeg, with a touch of butterscotch, the wine is medium to full bodied with medium nutty finish.
