Tasting Notes

Wild strawberries and spice on the palate. The palate continues with red and black berries, dried herbs looking like sage and thyme, and oak spice in the form of anise, tobacco and cedar. Very enjoyable.

Two Brothers Organic Shiraz 2022



Blind Corner, conceived by Ben & Naomi Gould in 2007, is the fruit of a journey that began in a rustic red builder’s van, traversing the surf breaks and wine regions of Western Europe. Upon their return in 2009, Ben and Naomi poured their passion and experience into their modest 4Ha vineyard, crafting wild wines with a hands-on approach. Now a 20Ha vineyard certified in Organic and Biodynamic practices, Blind Corner embraces natural methods with transparency and minimal intervention. Their wines, including Pétnat, Shiraz, Fortified, and Qvevri, are made ‘sans soufre’ (with nothing added), embodying pure natural winemaking. Beyond unique wines, Blind Corner pioneers regenerative farming and true natural winemaking in Australia. It’s not just a winery; it’s Ben and Naomi’s vision, a blend of love for the land, surf, and the art of natural winemaking.

Tasting Notes

It has a deep ruby colour with hints of purple. Aromas of dark cherry and plums are met with subtle notes of pepper, cinnamon and cloves. The palate is full-bodied and juicy with a pleasant balance between sweet and savoury. The tannins are smooth and gentle, with a long, lingering finish.
