Tasting Notes

A pleasing nose of nettles, green apple and limes. This wine has a pale lemon-green hue, with its crisp and zesty palate packed with lemon, green apple and freshly cut grass flavours. Its mouthfeel is full-bodied yet delicate, with a balanced acidity and a long, lingering finish.

Terre di Rai

Pinot Grigio 2022

Sandra De Giusti, with her 3 sons, is the owner of Terre di Rai. The winery is located on the left side of the Piave river in Treviso’s province, in the heart of Veneto region, between Venice and the Dolomites. Sandra De Giusti isn’t scared by challenges. She has promptly undertaken the route that finally led her to the realisation of a dream: working together with her sons and sharing with them a passion that is the grape vine cultivation and the production of great wines. This passion has been handing down from one generation to another, and it’s exactly the same one that, even now, is marking the work in the vineyards of this old farmer-rooted family. The lands are those that in the past belonged to the ancient aristocratic families of the area and that have been made fertile and fruitful by its farmers’ arms. Now it’s Sandra, supported by her sons, the custodian of these limitless estates, embroidered by native varieties, on the left side of the Piave river in Treviso’s province.

Tasting Notes

Classic example of grigio, fresh and crunchy orchard fruits including granny smith and green pear, layered with mineral with crushed earth and fresh lemon citrus blossom.
