Morgan's Reserve Chadonnay 2020

Originally the Morgan's label was based around a single vineyard high in the Adelaide Hills near Lenswood, but is now a regional blend, picking out the best of the Hills. Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc is the focus, but with the occasional spicy Shiraz for good measure.

Tasting Notes

This Chardonnay is a classic Adelaide Hills style with powerful nectarine, citrus, and white peach fruits with a touch of toasty, spicy oak. On the palate it is full bodied yet retains it's cool climate elegance with a supple, long finish.

The Pawn Pinot Grigio 2020

The Pawn Wine Co. began in 2002 as an experiment between friends - winemaker Tom Keelan and vigneron David Blows. The pair saw that alternative grape varieties were being used as blending tools by the bigger corporate wine companies instead of being stand alone artisinal Adelaide Hills wines of provenance. Tom and David realised the potential of these varietals to make "old world" wine styles and determined that they be allowed to shine in their own right.

Tasting Notes

On the palate the texture is very smooth, with juicy Nashi pear, Honeydew melon and lemon sherbet flavours all entwined with a middle palate viscos-ity that makes it both refreshing, soft and juicy. It is almost silk-like with over-tones of almonds and acacia flowers, citrus and spice and just enough natural acidity to give a clean crisp finish.

Thorn Clarke Terra Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon 2017

The Thorn-Clarke family are known as sixth generation wine region employees, establishing a winery to solidify their presence in the region. Wines are styled for premium consumption, with vineyards being paramount in the winemaking process.

Tasting Notes

From an absolutely stunning vintage, the wine is lifted and fragrant with violets, cherry, blackcurrant, blueberry, cassis and vanilla bean characters. The palate is lush with juicy raspberry, cherry, red and black currants flavours. Smooth, long, fine and very satisfying. Drink now to 2028.

Zilzie Regional Collection Barossa Shiraz 2018

Family owned and run by Roslyn Forbes and her sons Steven & Andrew, Zilzie Wines was established in 1999 after the Forbes Vineyards had already earned the family a dominant position as a supplier of grapes to large local wineries for over a decade. The Forbes family have farmed the Zilzie Estate since the early 1900s and after establishing their first vineyards in the mid 80's they are now exclusively devoted to grape growing and winemaking, and have converted over 600 hectares of the magnificent property to premium vineyards.

Tasting Notes

There is a lovely aromatic bouquet of dark berries and cedar spice. The palate is rich and luxurious with ripe cherry and plum characters, soft velvety tannins and a hint of spice on the finish.
