Allinda Goulburn Valley Shiraz 2016

Allinda Winery was established in 1990 by Al and Linda Fencaros, located in the foothills of the Great Dividing Range at the northern end of Yarra Valley. Al's grandparents commenced wine production in Hungary and later in Yugoslavia (now Serbia). Al's father migrated to Australia in the early 1960s where he produced wine following his family's traditional practices. Al initially graduated with honors from Melbourne University as an applied chemist, and later on graduated from Charles Sturt University with a second degree in wine science. After working as a winemaker at local wineries, he founded his own vineyard and winery in 1990. Ever since its establishment, Allinda Winery has been following its winemaking philosophy of a healthy balance between art and science, adapting or rejecting European practices depending on their suitability to the Australian climate, creating wines with excellent texture and an ability to mature into complex, world class wines.

Tasting Notes

Licorice and dark plum notes deliver abundant rich flavours and earthy fruit concentration with a slightly dry, savoury leathery finish.

Schoolhouse Headmaster Pinot Gris 2021



The winery is family owned is operated by a dedicated and experienced team. They have a reputation for exceptional quality and have supplied wine to some of Australia’s best known wineries. Wines that they have produced for clients have won many awards both locally and internationally. Set in a former limestone quarry, the sheer walls, show to perfection the signature white limestone topped by dramatic red terra rossa soil the region is famous for. The physical attributes of this setting are utilised, allowing gravity to ensure that fruit is handled as gently as possible. The state of the art equipment allows great flexibility in the handling, including whole fruit pressing, full/partial destemming, designed to maximise the potential of any fruit.

Tasting Notes

Fragrant nashi pear and lemon peel with subtle white floral aromas. Zesty citrus, apple and pear flavours are complemented by fine texture and fresh acidity, leading to a crisp dry finish.
