Idle Hill Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

One of the largest landholders in the Barossa, Grant Burge wines is a bastion of well made, value for money wines. Drawing on depth of experience in the region, Grant Burge and his wife Helen established the brand in 1988 and have developed a formidable range of wines across a broad spectrum of price points. The history of the Burge family and their long association with winemaking in the region can be traced back to March 1855, when noted tailor John Burge immigrated to the Barossa from Hillcot, near Pewsey in Wiltshire, England with his wife Eliza and their two sons.

Tasting Notes

Deep red in colour, with classic cabernet characters of cassis and blackberry, finishing with fine, silky tannins.

Mount Langi Ghiran has access to some of the best cool-climate shiraz material in Victoria. The 2018 TWC x MLG Cool Climate Shiraz is sourced from a selection of premium cool climate vineyards throughout Victoria; predominantly the Grampians including a portion from the Mount Langi Ghiran vineyards, home of the iconic Langi Shiraz. Peppery, fragrant, and silky-smooth cool-climate shiraz. This one is for lovers of spicy, medium to full-bodied red wines. The 2018 vintage delivered ideal growing conditions with a long dry summer and cool nights.

Tasting Notes

A layered, generous wine with bounds of aromatic florals and spice, luscious red and black fruits paired with finely structured tannins and mouth-watering acidity. A classic example of Mount Langi Ghiran.

Tasting Notes

If you're a Spanish wine lover of old then you'll know what this is about. If not, think aromatic reds (Pinot Noir, Gamay), but with more body and depth of flavour. This one is full of red berries and blue fruits with liquorice and allspice, topped off with a dusting of coffee and chocolate. It sits at 14% alcohol but hides it well under fine, silky tannins.

Caves St Pierre Cotes du Rhone Vieilles Vignes 2020

Caves Saint Pierre was created in 1898 by the Bouachon family who already owned the negociant firm of Maison Bouchon. The estate changed hands in 2001 when it was purchased by Skalli Family Wines. The Bouchon family continues to manage the estate and the negociant firm today. Caves Saint Pierre and Maison Bouchon produces and markets a wide range of wines from the Southern Rhone Valley from a myriad of appellations. Some of the appellations they produce are Chateauneuf-du-Pape, both red and white, Gigondas, Vacqueyras, Tavel, Ventoux as well as Cotes du Rhone.

Tasting Notes

Deep colour with youthful tints. Compelling nose showing a bouguet of cassis, redcurrant and raspberry. Supple, soft palate showcasing a distinctive fruit core supported by freshness.

Terramore Shiraz 2020



The name Terramore is a play on the words terroir, relating to the terra rossa soil of the Coonawarra, and the Italian word for love, amore. It is the newest addition to the Coonawarra region of South Australia created by third generation grape growers Phil and Mandy Gartner. The aim is to produce wines that are quintessential Coonawarra from their vineyards located in the heart of the region. The Terramore mission statement is 'Fine wines from the terroir of Coonawarra.' The first release was a 2009 full-flavoured, rich Cabernet Sauvignon, but they also produce crisp, tropical Sauvignon Blanc and plush cherry and plum Shiraz.

Tasting Notes

This Shiraz is full-bodied with a smooth rich texture. Notes of dark cherry, bay leaf and dark chocolate are followed by blackberry on the palate and balanced with hints of vanillin oak. The lengthy palate is mouth-filling and concentrated, displaying outstanding depth and intensity.
