Allinda Goulburn Valley Shiraz 2016

Allinda Winery was established in 1990 by Al and Linda Fencaros, located in the foothills of the Great Dividing Range at the northern end of Yarra Valley. Al's grandparents commenced wine production in Hungary and later in Yugoslavia (now Serbia). Al's father migrated to Australia in the early 1960s where he produced wine following his family's traditional practices. Al initially graduated with honors from Melbourne University as an applied chemist, and later on graduated from Charles Sturt University with a second degree in wine science. After working as a winemaker at local wineries, he founded his own vineyard and winery in 1990. Ever since its establishment, Allinda Winery has been following its winemaking philosophy of a healthy balance between art and science, adapting or rejecting European practices depending on their suitability to the Australian climate, creating wines with excellent texture and an ability to mature into complex, world class wines.

Tasting Notes

Licorice and dark plum notes deliver abundant rich flavours and earthy fruit concentration with a slightly dry, savoury leathery finish.

Made by Jeanneret Wines, Pure Clare represents the essence of the Clare. Unadulterated fruit, capturing the spirit of a region, crafted by the hands of the region's most coveted winemakers. K1 by Geoff Hardy Middle Hill Shiraz 2018

Geoff Hardy's great-great grandfather, the original Thomas Hardy, first planted grapes in South Australia in the 1850s and was one of the founding fathers of the Australian wine industry. In 1980, Geoff left the family company, Thomas Hardy and Sons, to make his own way in the Australian wine world. Geoff and fellow viticulturalist Ian Leask purchased the promising Pertaringa vineyard in McLaren Vale. A few years later, Geoff found the perfect location for producing cool climate grapes in the Adelaide Hills. He planted the vineyard in 1987 and named it K1 since this unique site was the first commercial planting of vines in the Kuitpo region in the southern Adelaide Hills.

Tasting Notes

Typical cool climate Shiraz aromas of red cherries and subtle spices, including cloves and white pepper. The palate is medium-bodied and complex with red plums, spice and a hint of apricot, followed by a grippy finish.

Old Jarvie 'The Saviour' Grenache Mataro Touriga 2019



There's an unseen partner at work in Old Jarvie's winemaking: the gulf that laps Adelaide's coastline. Matthew Flinders named it after the First Earl of St Vincent, Admiral John Jervis, whom the British sailors nicknamed Old Jarvie. Just as Old Jarvie was generous to those he considered worthy but swift to punish those who deserved it, the Gulf St Vincent's cooling sea breezes reward the best efforts with the ideal conditions for a range of approachable, contemporary wines. But Old Jarvie still never lets us forget who's really in charge.

Tasting Notes

Blackberry, raspberry, cocoa. Bright, bold fruit with spice, woody herbs, firm tannins, attitude in a good, fun way. Spanish house style of wine.

Nannup Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon 2019

Nannup Ridge Estate sits high on the granite ridges of the Blackwood River Escarpment inland from the Margaret River township. During the growing season, the vines enjoy long hours of sunshine followed by cool evenings and moderate coastal breezes in the afternoon, idyllic growing conditions. Abundant water, granite loam soils and low frost and disease pressure all contribute to reliable quality and consistent vintages. The first vines were planted in 1998, with subsequent plantings taking place in 2000, and 2006. The vineyard now comprises 16 hectares of Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, Merlot, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.

Tasting Notes

Medium dark red. Floral, berries, dark chocolate with spice. 14 months French oak. Intensely fruit driven, with vibrant red berries balanced with a fine and silky finish.
