Tasting Notes

The winery is family owned is operated by a dedicated and experienced team. They have a reputation for exceptional quality and have supplied wine to some of Australia's best known wineries. Wines that they have produced for clients have won many awards both locally and internationally. Set in a former limestone quarry, the sheer walls, show to perfection the signature white limestone topped by dramatic red terra rossa soil the region is famous for. The physical attributes of this setting are utilised, allowing gravity to ensure that fruit is handled as gently as possible. The state of the art equipment allows great flexibility in the handling, including whole fruit pressing, full/partial destemming, designed to maximise the potential of any fruit.

Tasting Notes

Fragrant nashi pear and lemon peel with subtle white floral aromas. Zesty citrus, apple and pear flavours are complemented by fine texture and fresh acidity, leading to a crisp dry finish.

Cool Woods Chardonnay 2022

The name Cool Woods was inspired by the rolling hills and scattered 'big gums' at their Angaston vineyard. These hills were once heavily forested with eucalypt, settlement of the region in the mid 1800's resulted in clearing of large grazing properties by the early settlers – today some of the gums still standing on our property are over 200 years old. Standing alongside the vineyard, these old trees would have seen some changes over the years – from early settlers arriving, to a working dairy and now a premium cool climate winery. Cool Woods wines are produced with fruit from this Eden Valley vineyard, along with grapes sourced from other South Australian winemaking regions. Combining their own fruit with grapes from other regions ensures that each vintage displays consistency, fantastic fruit qualities along with good varietal character and acid structure – ensuring the whites are crisp and clean, and the reds full of flavour and well balanced.

Tasting Notes

Pleasantly textured palate, steely minerality, notes of wet stone, gooseberry and white nectarine.

Monterra was founded in 2012 on the basis of an undeniable admiration for almighty mother nature, and the desire to bring exceptional wines to Australian tables and beyond. At the heart of Monterra is their decades-long relationships with their growers; the custodians of ancient soils and guardians of vines that reach for the sun and stars. Nurturers of hard-won soil magic that's the true root of it all.

South Australia's bountiful wine regions are where they find their sprawling home, from the northern point of the Barossa, to the Adelaide Hills, McLaren Vale and the Fleurieu Peninsula down south.

Tasting Notes

On the nose, this wine displays subtle citrus and asparagus aromas leading to a palate filled with white grapefruit and sun-soaked meadow hay. The ancient soils deliver a crisp, fresh and firm mineral finish.

Jeanneret Wines was established in 1992 by the Jeanneret family who were led heart first into the regions' vineyards. A passion for making wines purely for their own enjoyment organically expanded into a business and the Jeanneret cellar door was opened in October 1994. Headed up by self-taught Winemaker, Ben Jeanneret, their ethos is to produce generous wines full of flavour to be enjoyed amongst friends. Ben has perfected the art and is regarded as one of the leading winemakers of Clare Valley and was named one of the "Ten Dark Horses" by James Halliday. The business has continued to grow, change and innovate, but one thing has always remained the same – to make great wines from local grapes.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of citrus fruits, jasmine, and a subtle hint of green apples. On the palate, the wine is light, refreshing and crisp, presenting notes of lemon and lime zest, along with a suggestion of white peach.
