Barossa Shiraz 2020

One of the largest landholders in the Barossa, Grant Burge wines is a bastion of well made, value for money wines. Drawing on depth of experience in the region, Grant Burge and his wife Helen established the brand in 1988 and have developed a formidable range of wines across a broad spectrum of price points. The history of the Burge family and their long association with winemaking in the region can be traced back to March 1855, when noted tailor John Burge immigrated to the Barossa from Hillcot, near Pewsey in Wiltshire, England with his wife Eliza and their two sons.

Tasting Notes

A typical big, bold and bright Shiraz. Aromas of chocolate, coffee, spice and ripe berry. A palate of juicy raspberry and mocha is rounded off by subtle use of oak, presenting a smooth finish of silky, soft tannins.

Located in Coonawarra, at the heart of South Australia’s Limestone Coast, Coonawarra Wines is a modern, efficient winery, capable of crafting unique parcels of high quality wine. Byron & Harold Chapter & Verse Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

Two lovers of wine, not just the drinking of it; but the romance of it, the history of it and the pleasure and – yes – inspiration it has given human beings for thousands of years. One with the surname Byron, the other with the given name Harold; two gentlemen, really, in the true sense of the word, but with a secret admiration for the 19th century English poet who in his day was regarded as ‘mad, bad and dangerous to know.’ With more than a lifetime of combined experience in the Australian wine trade, Paul Byron and Harold (Ralph) Dunning seek out those parcels of wine that they believe Australian wine lovers really want to drink. Wines with flavour, wines that are true to their variety – wines with provenance.

Tasting Notes

Lifted aromatics of cassis, bay leaf, forest fruits and savoury spice. The palate is very concentrated, with fine dusty tannins, soft acidity and notes of satsuma plum, blackberry & dark chocolate. Long, savoury finish.

Their daughter Christina took charge of business operations and in two short years has managed to turn Krystallo Estate vineyard into a family owned and operated business. Jim and Maria’s children, grandchildren, nephews and nieces all contribute from vineyard to company management. Leaving the winemaking to some local experts including Ros Ritchie, Sam Plunket and Rob Dolan & Co just to name a few.

Tasting Notes

Bright straw colour with a golden hue. Elegant combination of citrus, green pear, and bright tropical fruits. The palate is fresh and crisp with a zesty, lingering acidity on the finish.

Morgan’s Reserve Sauvignon Blanc 2021

Originally the Morgan’s label was based around a single vineyard high in the Adelaide Hills near Lenswood, but is now a regional blend, picking out the best of the Hills. Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc is the focus, but with the occasional spicy Shiraz for good measure.

Tasting Notes

The nose is fresh, inviting and floral. Vibrant tropical fruits, melon and peach mingle on the palate with fine, zippy acidity leading to a long and refreshing finish.
