Euchareena Road Orange Chardonnay 2018



Established in 1995, the 508 hectare Cumulus vineyard is one of the largest single vineyard's in New South Wales, and which gently rises and falls across a range of elevations and slopes above and below 600m – traversing both the Orange and Central Ranges wine regions. In such unique surroundings the Cumulus vineyard provides a range of elevations, terrains, volcanic soils and aspects, which combined with the area's high altitude, intense sunlight and cool climate, delivers wines with bright fruit flavours and subtle elegance. Cumulus Wines are crafted by a winemaking team led by the highly respected Group Chief Winemaker Rod Hooper in the Riverina and Debbie Lauritz in Orange.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of grapefruit & citrus with complex yeasty notes and a hint of struck match. The palate is complex, elegant, tightly structured and softly textured with a creamy mouthfeel, citrus, stonefruit, subtle oak and great length.

Sorby Adams' winemaker, Simon Adams, is an experienced winemaker, with a career spanning nearly 30 years in Australia's leading wine companies including Chief Winemaker at Yalumba Wine Company and Dorrien Estate, as well as many vintages overseas including Alsace (France), St Emillion, Napa Valley, and New Zealand. His viticultural and winemaking philosophy is based on the belief that great wines are made in the vineyard. He places enormous emphasis on careful tending of vines with minimal intervention ensuring that he has access to the highest quality fruit.

Tasting Notes

This wine was fermented then matured in older French oak barrels for 10 months. It is a light and crisp style with flavours of apple, pear and a hint of rose petal.

Purveyors of fine wines exclusively from the Keil Estate vineyard, underpinned with an investment in patience by extended cellaring time prior to release. It is a philosophy free of the compromises that can come when growing grapes to then the winemaking. Everything comes back to the source. Keil's measure of success is a wine that is true to its origins. While excellence is a constant, their wines change year by year with every variable, including the development of the vines themselves. They will always make the best, but they will never make 'the same'; rather, they make wines whose flavour profiles speak clearly of a parcel of vines and its fruit captured and crafted during one unique season in its life.

Tasting Notes

Notes of vanilla on the nose, the palate is broad and oak is present, showing candied fruits, apple and grape, jasmine, medium to fuller body with a long finish.

Tasting Notes

Willow Bridge Water Dancer Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2023

Two hours south of Perth in the Ferguson Valley sub-region of Geographe is where you'll find Willow Bridge Estate. Jeff and Vicki Dewar bought the vineyard in 1996 and enlisted the expertise of Kim Horton and Dougal Herd to create premium wines that are exceptional value for money. In 1997 they planted 100 acres of wine grapes – and held their breath. Then another 50 acres were planted in 1998, making Willow Bridge the biggest planting in what was then a largely unknown region. The vineyard is sited high on the western watershed of the Darling Ranges, with the vines enjoying spectacular views over the coastal plain, and across the waters of Geographe Bay to Cape Naturaliste.

Tasting Notes

Lifted passionfruit, tropical fruits and lime zest with moderate herbaceous notes. Crisp and refreshing palate, delicately balanced with fresh summer fruits and a long fine finish.
