Tapanappa Tiers Vineyard 1.5M Chardonnay 2021



Tapanappa is the continuation of the 40-year mission of pioneering winemaker Brian Croser and his family to make world-class wines from the most “Distinguished Sites” in South Australia.

With a next generation of family closely involved, Brian continues his passion to achieve the finest expression of his choice of noble varieties in their best suited terroirs, no matter what each vintage brings.

Tasting Notes

Because of the small crop, 2019 Tiers 1.5M Chardonnay is exquisitely concentrated. Pale green/lemon in colour, the aroma is of white peach, canteloupe and the faint cinnamon and vanilla of Fench oak.

Soumah Equilibrio Chardonnay 2021

Soumah Wines set out to select an exact location that delivered every advantage of a cool climate, undulating topography and ancient soils. Inspired by the elegance and honesty of Northern Italian wines and food the team decided to focus their endeavours on the wines of this region. They found just the right vineyard, located down a county lane in

the dress circle Warramate foothills of the Yarra Valley and from here they set out to make wine with the charm of Northern Italy but the provenance of the majestic Yarra Valley. Situated an average of 120 metres above sea level, their vineyard is elevated up off the valley floor which gives some protection against winter frosts while gentle slopes help drain the soil.

Tasting Notes

Tight aromatics of grapefruit and nectarine are supported by hints of toasted oak and struck match. A focused and complex palate shows freshness and youth with restrained elegance. This wine will evolve over many years to come.

Vina Somoza Ededia Godello 2019

The Ededia Godello uses grapes from near ‘Serra da Enciña da Lastra’, a national park and one of the most gorgeous locales in the Valdeorras valley. The plot itself has an altitude of 450 metres and vines that are 40 years old. The soils here are chock-full of limestone and receive a consistent,

sunny exposure. How’s it look in the glass? It’s golden and shimmering with notes of shortcrust pastry and ripe orchard fruit (think nashi pear, apple and quince) and a fine line of minerality. It’s opulent but elegant with a full palate but the acidity is fresh to balance it out.

Tasting Notes

The nose is subtle, with ripe apples, quince and sweet citrus fruit and a mineral freshness. Balanced and silky, with a rich finish.

Voerzio Martini Barolo 2017

cellar founded by Gianni Voerzio in La Morra. His successful and extensive experience as wine producer is now supported by the innovative ideas of the oenologist Mirko Martini and Federica Martini.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of dark-skinned berries, mocha and underbrush emerge from the glass. The firm, structured palate offers dried blackberry, licorice and vanilla alongside polished tannins.

Corymbia Margaret River Cabernet Sauvignon 2020



Corymbia is the deep-rooted, far-sighted vision of husband-and wife-team, Rob and Genevieve Mann. The Mann name is synonymous with Western Australia’s Swan Valley, where Rob’s pioneering grandfather Jack worked a remarkable 51

consecutive vintages for Houghton. Rob was just a boy when he joined his father - former Australian test cricketer Tony - in planting the vines on what is now the dry-grown, organically farmed Corymbia vineyard.

Tasting Notes

This wine tastes of the grape, the dirt and the season without pretention, which is exactly what we want. Pomegranate, wild blackberries, violets and salted licorice characters are complemented by a palate of great energy and drive. It’s all framed by the vineyard’s typical graphite-like structure.

Wild Earth Reserve ‘Earth and Sky’ Pinot Noir 2020



Only the very best grapes from vineyards in the well renowned Bannockburn area are selected to produce this ‘Earth and Sky’ Pinot Noir 2020. This wine is a blend of three Bannockburn vineyards ranging from 11 to 20 years old. One of the sites is planted on the sandier soils of Cairnmuir Road and the other two border the Bannockburn Sluicings, a distinctive geographic landmark that is steeped in mining history. The grapes from these vineyards were fermented

separately with a range of 0-100% whole clusters with the resulting blend having around 15% whole clusters which aids the tannin structure and aromatics of the wine. The total time on skins ranging from 18-25 days. The wine was aged for approximately 12 months in fine grain French oak barriques with 25% new and the rest ranging from 2-5 years old. The wine was bottled unfinned, unfiltered; as such, natural deposits may occur. This wine is vegan.

Tasting Notes

An extremely aromatic nose with cherry, plum, lilac, incense, cedar, wild thyme and a hint of gun smoke. This is an intensely concentrated expression of the Bannockburn sub-region with lovely red and blue fruit, florals and a hint of game supported by fine tannins that are intricately woven around the fresh acidity.
