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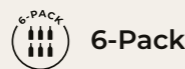
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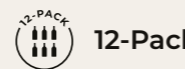

Yelland & Papps Barossa Valley Second Take Mataro 2020

Yelland & Papps is a 1st generation husband and wife team starting in 2005 in the iconic Barossa Valley, using a minimal intervention approach to create elegant, structured fruit-forward wines to enjoy in a social aspect or can cellar gracefully for many years to come. In the winery there a focus on using a lot of whole bunch fermentation, no filtration, larger format oak and putting 100% whole bunches in puncheons and letting them sit for up to

a year in some cases. All wines are wild fermented, unfiltered, vegan friendly and unfiltered with only a couple whites being filtered. Their wines showcase fruit as the hero and using a lighter touch with fine grain oak, make wines that are delicate and elegant. Using minimal inputs during the winemaking process to allow the fruit to speak in a clear voice, uncluttered by overzealous oak and a heavy hand.

Tasting Notes

A bouquet of violet aromas makes way for a rich palate of dark cherries, chocolate and Asian spice. Ageing will be highly rewarding, resulting in aniseed and hoisin characteristics along with blue fruit and cedar notes.

Chateau Yaldara Grand Pappy Shiraz 2018

Inspired by its founder Hermann Thumm who first started crafting Barossa Wines in 1947 and was one of the regions first boutique winemakers. Thumm pushed the boundaries

of Australian winemaking through his appetite for experimentation with wine techniques, styles and blends.

Tasting Notes

The fruit concentration is absolutely immaculate in this wine! The palate is dense, rich and inky with an explosion of blackberry, that is kept in check by a thick blanket of cherry tannins. A warm, seductive, finish.

Taylor's St Andrews Riesling 2022

Established in 1969, Taylor's Wines represents a family history of great winemaking. Three generations have built on the legacy of dedicated winemaking in the Clare Valley, with a focus on respect for the vineyard and fruit, and particular care

in the winery. The winery is headed up by third generation winemaker Mitchell Taylor, supported by Chief Winemaker Adam Eggins, and a group of highly skilled winemakers, who all work to ensure the consistent quality of the Taylor's range.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of zesty lemon and lime with a hint of orange blossom. Fresh citrus flavours with crisp and refreshing lime acidity down the mid-palate, complimented by a persistent and refreshing finish.

Domaine Robert Denogent Macon Villages Les Sardines 2020

In 1988, Jean-Jacques Robert took over the 5 ha of vineyards, that until then were managed by his father and sold to local cooperatives. Now his sons Nico and Antoine are slowing taking over, two of the rising stars of the region. The Robert family manage small parcels over a total of 8.5 ha of organically farmed old vines, on mixed soils of granite, shale, silt, clay and gravel. They have also begun to experiment with biodynamics

in the vineyards, while in the winery they take a very natural approach to vinification. Ageing their wines for between 1 to 1.5 years in second and third fill local oak barrels, the wines bear a close resemblance in style to some of the more highly regarded sub-appellations such as Meursault and Puligny Montrachet. Complexity, intensity, and authenticity, this is what defines the wines of Domaine Robert Denogent.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of ripe white fruit, pastry notes and toasty touches. On the palate it is intense, creamy and enveloping. It reveals a good structure, crisp acidity and a long finish.

Tahbilk 1927 Vines Marsanne 2015

The name Tahbilk comes from the language of the Daung-wurrung clans, the first people in the area. They called it tabilk-tabilk which means place of many waterholes. Tahbilk Wines was established in 1860 in the Nagambie lakes sub region of Victoria's Goulburn Valley. It is home to a unique meso-climate, influenced by inland lakes and lagoons fed from the Goulburn River. Purchased by the Purbrick family in 1925, Tahbilk is home to 5 generations. Tahbilk is home to

200 hectares of vine, including the traditional Rhone Valley varieties Marsanne, Viognier, Roussanne, Shiraz, Grenache and Mourvedre. Classic varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Chardonnay, Riesling, Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc and Verdelho are also present. Tahbilk's flagship 1860 Vines Shiraz is produced from the estate's original 1/2 ha of ungrafted, pre-phylloxera Shiraz vines that are amongst the oldest in the world.

Tasting Notes

Vivacious ginger spice, lemon curd, and hints of honeysuckle grace a palate of searingly intense citrus and tropical fruits braced by a prodigious mineral-edged acid line that will carry this wine well into the future with further character and complexity still to be realised.
