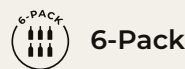

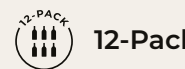

Casa E di Mirafiore Barbera d'Alba Superiore DOC 2018



Founded in 1878 by Italy's Royal Family, the Mirafiore winery is the estate that gave Barolo its nickname: "The King of Wines, the Wine of Kings." It is named after Emanuele Alberto Guerrieri di Mirafiori, the son of King Vittorio Emanuele II, the first monarch to rule after Italy's unification and the first to make wine on what would become the E. Mirafiore estate. Certified organic since 2018, Mirafiore sources the fruit for its wines from estate-owned vineyards primarily in Serralunga d'Alba

commune, one of the appellation's top growing zones, known for the power and longevity of the wines it produces. The estate also owns rows in two of Barolo's most famous crus, Lazzarito and Paiagallo. The winemaking style is strictly traditional. The winemaker uses submerged cap maceration to achieve the wine's classic colour and tannic structure. Extended aging in large-format Slavonian casks (Barolo's famous "botti") gives the wine the appellation's signature nuance and depth.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of ripe dark fruit, coffee, licorice, sweet spices and woody hints. The sip is long, persistent and very well balanced between acidity, flavour and softness. Very pleasant.

Terre Del Barolo Barolo 2017



One of the marvels of this region is the "Terre del Barolo" winery in Castiglione Falletto, established amidst the vineyards that grow one of the world's most illustrious wines: Barolo. A family of smallholders – because that is what each of its three hundred members has remained – living,

farming and nourishing the land, while adding value to their enterprise with their own culture, history and customs. Every cluster tells the story of the miracle of the seasons, of the sun and the rain, of work that encompasses thousands of nuances.

Tasting Notes

A floral nose with dried leaves, strawberries and earthy notes. Full-bodied with persistent fruit and a nicely formed tannin structure. Will soften and gain added complexity with age.

Mitchell Wines McNicol Shiraz 2009



Jane and Andrew Mitchell established the winery in 1975 on the Mitchell family property in the western hills of the Clare Valley in South Australia. An old sandstone apple store was converted to serve as a rustic cellar door. Continued growth has resulted in further development of the winery buildings

and winemaking plant. Currently, some 500-700 tonnes of premium fruit is crushed and processed in a well equipped modern winery. The imposing two-storey century-old family home sits amid the vineyards, overlooking the winery.

Tasting Notes

Fragrant, spicy perfume lift on the nose. Complex palate with youthful dark fruit, exotic spice and fresh acidity elegantly balancing the fine tannins. A quintessential Clare Valley Shiraz.

Jacob's Creek Orlando Steingarten Riesling 2007



Orlando was the name of a vineyard that was established in Rowland Flat, Barossa Valley by the legendary Gramp family in 1874. In the 50s and 60s Orlando became a powerhouse for technological innovation in Australia by introducing

techniques which made significant advancements to delivering improved quality wines. In 2020 Orlando's legendary wines once again capture all that is great about Australian classics.

Tasting Notes

Incredible aromas of kerosene, matchstick, very subtle lemon. Palate is richly textured, smooth, yet stern and flinty with a crunchy acidity.

Maison Dousset Chablis 2019

Paterne and Baudouin continue the family business to develop the estate which is now 14 hectares: 9 hectares in AOC Petit Chablis, 4 hectares in AOC Chablis and 1 hectare in AOC Chablis 1er Cru Vaucoupin. The desire to cultivate the best vines and produce the best Chardonnay grapes in order to

offer wines with fine aromas, that are elegant and reflect the "terroir" that Chablis is known for, is what drives the two men each and every day.

Tasting Notes

Supple, round mouthfeel with lots of aromatic density and structure. Fine acidity provides the freshness of white currant. The long finish is light and defined by a spicy note of white pepper. A Chablis of structure and elegance.

La Crema Monterey Chardonnay 2021



Over 30 years of experience working with Chardonnay and Pinot Noir have established La Crema as a winery of consistent quality. La Crema produces wines from top cool-climate appellations to include; Russian River Valley, Sonoma Coast, Monterey and most recently Willamette. The unifying factors of all these sites are their cool, windy climates and marine-based soils. La Crema's vineyards are all harvested by hand in

the cooler morning hours. The winemaking techniques are primarily traditional with modern enhancements to ensure that the wines are true to both the variety and the terroir. Chardonnays are whole-cluster pressed and fermented and aged in French oak on the lees with bi-monthly battonage to add texture and complexity.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of baked apple, graham cracker, meyer lemon and pineapple. Followed by flavours of Asian pear, orange, tangerine, notes of minerality with a balanced acidity and a long finish.
