

Nightfall 'LEO' Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

A special project from Sam Brand, Nightfall wines are created to provide a feeling of luxury, style and exclusivity. An extremely limited series of wines, all sourced from single vineyard sites with a definitive sense of origin; a pure representation of the soil, the site and the stars. The concept for Nightfall was born after a dinner with customers,

winemaker Sam Brand, walked outside to find his clients all looking up, mesmerised by the clarity and beauty of the night sky above Coonawarra. Having never seen the stars so vividly, his guests stood in awe and likened the stars to diamonds in the sky. The uniqueness of this moment, an experience shared and always remembered was the inspiration for Nightfall.

Tasting Notes

A classic wine in style and sophistication. Deep purple with red hues, the palate displays true varietal character, with deep blackberry, cassis, mint and a hint of smooth cedar oak on the midpalate.



Hither & Yon Leask Grenache 2019

Born into wine, the Leask brothers have been able to group a selection of vineyards spread across McLaren Vale, between hills & sea, under their own family estate. Richard is the outside man, farmer and maker; Malcolm is the inside guy, director and creator. What started as their "bottle project" in 2011 has now endured and sprouted into a much-loved wine brand. The Leasks see the two most important things

in their life as being soil and people. If both are healthy and happy then good things will follow. Now, more than ever, they identify regenerative agriculture as their guiding philosophy. It is a dynamic holistic system which is down to earth, but also futurist. It is input focused, not process or market driven. This way of farming is a struggle, but this brings tension to the wine, and truly expresses vineyard and variety.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of rose petal perfume, sweet spice, red berries, leather couch, aniseed. Palate notes of cherry and raspberry, pine needle and clove spice. Caramel, tangerine and vanilla, mint.

Boroli Langhe Belami Chardonnay 2021

A Piedmontese family of entrepreneurs since 1831. Firstly in the textile industry, then in publishing and now also in winegrowing. In the 90's, Silvano and Elena Boroli felt the need to start a new project that could bring them back to nature, far from the crazy rhythms of today. The choice was almost

obligatory for a Piedmontese: Langa wines. A passion that has converted into a job. What could be better? A very difficult and demanding job, whose results are never achieved by chance, but, precisely for this reason, with great satisfaction.

Tasting Notes

Abundant notes of soft pear and Golden Delicious apple. Chalky mineral is spread throughout the wine's almost creamy, mid-weight texture. Fruity mouthfeel, a good acidity, finishing with subtle oak spice.

Brookland Valley Estate Chardonnay 2021

Sustainable viticulture and winemaking with minimal inputs allows Brookland Estate's unique location and vineyard to speak for themselves in their wine. James Halliday has consistently recognised Brookland Valley as an outstanding

winery and again, in 2019 was awarded 5 Star Winery. Brookland Valley has achieved 5 Red Stars (top 3.5% of all Australian wineries) for 10 consecutive years (Halliday Wine Companion).

Tasting Notes

Bright aromas of white peach and nectarine, pink grapefruit, ginger and lime. Followed by hints of flint, hazelnuts, cashews and fresh brioche. The palate shows flavours of grapefruit, nougat, nectarine and ginger spices.

Domaine Sautereau Sancerre Blanc 2022

Domaine Sautereau is now managed by David Sautereau, belonging to the 10th generation of producers. David was very early convinced that he would be destined to pursue the family adventure, and studied wine in Burgundy and Champagne. In order to expand its wine culture, he made several experiments in foreign vineyards (Switzerland, USA and Australia). He then made his first harvest in 1997 and worked

closely with his parents. David is committed to perpetuating family know-how while adapting to new techniques to make the most of its terroir. The vineyard now counts 22 hectares: 2/3 in Sauvignon blanc on the communes of Crézancy and Bué for the development of the white Sancerre and 1/3 in Pinot Noir on the communes of Crézancy, Bué and Sancerre for the development of the red and rosé Sancerre.

Tasting Notes

Incredible minerality with salty crushed rocks, fresh grape fruit, and pineapple. Fresh and dry but a slight touch of sweetness giving richness.
