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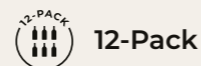
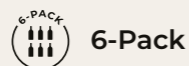

## Heirloom Alcala McLaren Vale Grenache 2021



Heirloom Vineyards was conceived in vintage 2000, when a young winemaking student caught the eye of a silly old wine judge. A love story ensued inspired by two vows: To preserve the best of tradition, the old world of wine and our unique old vineyards and to champion the best clones of each variety

planted in the most appropriate sites embracing the principals of organic and biodynamic farming. Seven long vintages of trial and error passed before Heirloom Vineyards could make a wine that was fine enough to pass on to future generations. That is this wine.

### Tasting Notes

The plush, generous fruit is brilliantly offset by plating tannins and a zippy acidity. All of these qualities crash together at the end of the palate. Notes of cherried fruits, puckering tannins, and piquant acidity.

## Brand & Sons Coonawarra “Glenroy” Single Vineyard Shiraz 2016



The Brand family legacy dates back to 1852, stretching over six generations. Today, Brand & Sons is owned and managed by fourth generation vigneron Sam Brand, producing boutique

wine using high quality products from select vineyard sites across South Australia.

### Tasting Notes

Aromas of dark plum and ripe cherry, with dark chocolate, tobacco and charry toasted oak. Palate notes of deep currants and plum with mouth-coating tannins that match the intensity of the fruit and hold strong through the finish.

## Eon Pinot Noir 2017



Tom Bullen, Cleighthen Cornelius and Andrew Brown, make up the team behind Eon and consider the project to be one which brings together viticulture and winemaking. They are dedicated to producing Pinot Noir which illuminates the

Bendigo site and speaks to the vintage. Selecting the grapes (based on clones and location within the vineyard) and nurturing them through the season, requires time, dedication and patience.

### Tasting Notes

Deep ruby with fresh aromas of dark berries and ripe cherry, sweet florals, dried herbs and baking spice. The palate is integrated and complex with juicy acidity, silky tannins and a long, luscious finish.

## Longview Vineyard ‘Macclesfield’ Chardonnay 2020

Longview is a stunning, family-owned Adelaide Hills single vineyard located just outside the historic township of Macclesfield. Set on undulating slopes reminiscent of old world estates but with a clear Australian accent, it has quickly established itself as one of the most awarded vineyards in the region since its first vintage in 2001.

Operations are overseen by brothers Mark and Peter Saturno, along with a small but specialised team. They ensure the vineyard is fastidiously managed to produce the finest fruit for their premium estate grown wines and provide a wine tourism experience that has placed Longview in the South Australian Tourism ‘Hall of Fame’.

### Tasting Notes

Generous aromas of butterscotch and lime, with a rich, opulent palate. Notes of ginger, brine, citrus and a round, creamy mouthfeel leading to a long, luscious finish.

## Domaine Sautereau Sancerre Blanc 2020



Domaine Sautereau is now managed by David Sautereau, belonging to the 10th generation of producers.

He then made his first harvest in 1997 and worked closely with his parents. David is committed to perpetuating family know-how while adapting to new techniques to make the most of its terroir. The vineyard now counts 22 hectares: 2/3 in Sauvignon blanc on the communes of Crézancy and Bué for the development of the white Sancerre and 1/3 in Pinot Noir on the communes of Crézancy, Bué and Sancerre for the development of the red and rosé Sancerre.

David was very early convinced that he would be destined to pursue the family adventure, and studied wine in Burgundy and Champagne. In order to expand its wine culture, he made several experiments in foreign vineyards (Switzerland, USA and Australia).

### Tasting Notes

Pale to medium lemon. Intense aromatic and fresh nose with delicate aromas of white stones fruits, citrus, mango and floral notes. A pure and elegant wine with a straight and persistent finish followed by a beautiful minerality.

## Maison Dousset Chablis 2019

Paterne and Baudouin continue the family business to develop the estate which is now 14 hectares: 9 hectares in AOC Petit Chablis, 4 hectares in AOC Chablis and 1 hectare in AOC Chablis 1er Cru Vaucoupin. The desire to cultivate the

best vines and produce the best Chardonnay grapes in order to offer wines with fine aromas, that are elegant and reflect the “terroir” that Chablis is known for, is what drives the two men each and every day.

### Tasting Notes

Supply, round mouthfeel with lots of aromatic density and structure. Fine acidity provides the freshness of white currant. The long finish is light and defined by a spicy note of white pepper. A Chablis of structure and elegance.
