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

## Yelland & Papps Barossa Valley Second Take Mataro 2020

Yelland & Papps is a 1st generation husband and wife team starting in 2005 in the iconic Barossa Valley, using a minimal intervention approach to create elegant, structured fruit-forward wines to enjoy in a social aspect or can cellar gracefully for many years to come. In the winery there a focus on using a lot of whole bunch fermentation, no filtration, larger format oak and putting 100% whole bunches in puncheons and letting them sit for up to

a year in some cases. All wines are wild fermented, unfined, vegan friendly and unfiltered with only a couple whites being filtered. Their wines showcase fruit as the hero and using a lighter touch with fine grain oak, make wines that are delicate and elegant. Using minimal inputs during the winemaking process to allow the fruit to speak in a clear voice, uncluttered by overzealous oak and a heavy hand.

#### **Tasting Notes**

A bouquet of violet aromas makes way for a rich palate of dark cherries, chocolate and Asian spice. Ageing will be highly rewarding, resulting in aniseed and hoisin characteristics along with blue fruit and cedar notes.

## Chateau Yaldara Grand Pappy Shiraz 2018

Inspired by its founder Hermann Thumm who first started crafting Barossa Wines in 1947 and was one of the regions first boutique winemakers. Thumm pushed the boundaries of Australian winemaking through his appetite for experimentation with wine techniques, styles and blends.

#### **Tasting Notes**

The fruit concentration is absolutely immaculate in this wine! The palate is dense, rich and inky with an explosion of blackberry, that is kept in check by a thick blanket of charry tannins. A warm, seductive, finish,

## **Longview Vineyard** Nebbiolo 'Saturnus' 2016

Located just outside the historic township of Macclesfield, the Longview vineyard is set on undulating slopes reminiscent of old world estates but with a clear Australian accent, it has quickly established itself as one of the most awarded vineyards in the region since its first vintage in 2001. Operations are overseen by brothers Mark and Peter Saturno, along with a small but specialised team. They ensure the vineyard is fastidiously managed to produce the finest fruit

for their premium estate grown wines. As they say, 'It's all about the site.' Longview is proud to be part of the cool, clean and green region of the Adelaide Hills but it's the particular micro-climate in the South of the region that makes this vineyard so special. Ancient soils, healthy rainfall, undulating slopes, gentle sun, warm days and cool nights, are an essential part of this unique vineyard's 'terroir' and something you can truly experience in every glass.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Alluring and intense nose of licorice and cherry with floral nuances. The palate is rich, complex and spicy, medium to full-bodied, with savoury fruit, refreshing acidity and structured dusty tannins, with a herbaceous finish.

## **Tahbilk Eric Stevens Purbrick** Cabernet Sauvignon 2016

The name Tahbilk comes from the language of the Daungwurrung clans, the first people in the area. They called it tabilk-tabilk which means place of many waterholes. Tahbilk Wines was established in 1860 in the Nagambie lakes sub region of Victoria's Goulburn Valley. It is home to a unique meso-climate, influenced by inland lakes and lagoons fed

from the Goulburn River. Purchased by the Purbrick family in 1925, Tahbilk is home to 5 generations. Tahbilk's flagship 1860 Vines Shiraz is produced from the estate's original 1/2 ha of ungrafted, pre-phylloxera Shiraz vines that are amongst the oldest in the world.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Aromas of cassis, mulberries, sandalwood and eucalypt alongside cigar and tea-leaf notes guide you to a richly flavoured palate of exotic spice and dark fruit flavours supported by velvety tannins on a deliciously long finish. Region Nagambie Lakes, VIC

### **James Kalleske CYME** Old Vine Grenache 2021

Barossa-raised winemaker James Kalleske has been in the industry for two decades. He has helmed wineries in Margaret River; learned producer secrets in Champagne, Sancerre, and Yecla; and developed a range of award-winning new-latitude wines in Bali. Under the old oak tree at Rockfield Estate, he made his first gold-medal-winning wine — a Sauvignon Blanc Semillon. When he left to take up a position with Hatten Wines in Bali, he brought with him a new appreciation for the region's lighter, more elegant wine styles. After 17 years away from South Australia, JKW represents both a reunion and the realisation of a lifelong dream: to make his own wines in his own way.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Aromas of glacé cherries, juniper and poached quinces. The palate is soft and plush, with powdery tannins leading to an elegant oak backbone. A subtle earthiness and Szechuan pepper liveliness on the finish.
