A special project from Sam Brand, Nightfall wines are created to provide a feeling of luxury, style and exclusivity. An extremely limited series of wines, all sourced from single vineyard sites with a definitive sense of origin; a pure representation of the soil, the site and the stars. The concept for Nightfall was born after a dinner with customers,

winemaker Sam Brand, walked outside to find his clients all looking up, mesmerised by the clarity and beauty of the night sky above Coonawarra. Having never seen the stars so vividly, his guests stood in awe and likened the stars to diamonds in the sky. The uniqueness of this moment, an experience shared and always remembered was the inspiration for Nightfall.



Tasting Notes

A classic wine in style and sophistication. Deep purple with red hues, the palate displays true varietal character, with deep blackberry, cassis, mint and a hint of smooth cedar oak on the midpalate.

Hither & Yon Leask Grenache 2019

Born into wine, the Leask brothers have been able to group a selection of vineyards spread across McLaren Vale, between hills & sea, under their own family estate. Richard is the outside man, farmer and maker; Malcolm is the inside guy, director and creator. What started as their "bottle project" in 2011 has now endured and sprouted into a much-loved wine brand. The Leasks see the two most important things

in their life as being soil and people. If both are healthy and happy then good things will follow. Now, more than ever, they identify regenerative agriculture as their guiding philosophy. It is a dynamic holistic system which is down to earth, but also futurist. It is input focused, not process or market driven. This way of farming is a struggle, but this brings tension to the wine, and truly expresses vineyard and variety.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of rose petal perfume, sweet spice, red berries, leather couch, aniseed. Palate notes of cherry and raspberry, pine needle and clove spice. Caramel, tangerine and vanilla, mint.

Tasting Notes

Rich aromas of intense mocha, blackberries with dark earthy spicy, cedary oak. Palate shows intensity, richness and a generous mouthfeel filled with blackberries, plum, subtle vanillan oak, held together with silky smooth tannins.

Dalwhinnie Three Valleys Pinot Noir 2020

Dalwhinnie is located near the small village of Moonambel in the heart of the Pyrenees region of Western Victoria, Australia and is a super premium producer of Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Chardonnay. After 40 years of growing grapes, the 16 hectare vineyard is now fully mature, producing true varietal fruit characters with great concentration of flavours.

At 595 metres above sea-level Dalwhinnie is the highest and most remote of the Pyrenees district vineyards. Surrounded and sheltered by the highest range, this unique bowl of vines is a world unto itself, located in a naturally undulating trough which falls away from the hills, forming an amphitheatre nestled into the ranges.



Tasting Notes

An array of red berries, blood orange and dark cherry on the nose. Brightly fruited on the front palate, concentrated plum, cranberry and sweet bergamot flavours are woven together with mineral acidity and fine, powdered tannins.

Arila Gardens Gardens of Moppa Saperavi 2022

In beginning this chapter, it was vital for all members of the family to show their deep respect for the land and encompass the full history from where it came. This led them first of all to choose the name Arila, which is an Aboriginal word for 'sand, land and earth'. Thus, honouring the original owners of the land, as well as the mix of sand, ironstone and quartz that the roots of these ancient vines reach deep into. These vineyards are regarded as "Gardens"

and are nurtured and tended with care and pride. To have the opportunity to use holistic and sustainable approaches, and be so connected to the wine and land on which they are grown, is a dream come true. Their Gardens are: Sand Garden, Quartz Garden, and Ironstone Garden. And to honour vignerons before them, they have named their wines simply from the 'gardens' on which the grapes are grown.



Tasting Notes

Evolving aromas of fresh beetroot, lemon thyme, plum and floral flecks. Blood plum and purple fig is complexed with earthy warm spice and subtle savoury oak on the palate. The tannins build and grow, providing a robust depth.
