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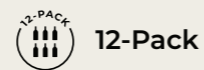
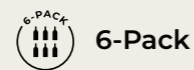

Chateau Fourcas-Dupré 2017



Welcome to the heart of the Médoc, a name synonymous with joie de vivre amid the great Bordeaux wine region. Our estate and your wine are part of a special history within a bucolic setting 35 km from Bordeaux. At the beginning of the 13th century, vines appeared at the locality of "Fourcas", as noted in the cartographic work by the geographer

Pierre de Belleyme during the reign of Louis XV. The name "Fourcas Dupré" came into being in 1843 when Maître Jean Antoine Dupré became the owner. Taken over by the Pagès family in 1970, the estate continued to uphold the same ethos of precision, expertise and passion.

Tasting Notes

Layers of tannins in this wine really sculpted like a classic example, while leaving room for the wines black currant fruit. There is also menthol, cinnamon, clove, a full bodied example, great for the price.

Grounded Cru Inc Single Vineyard Shiraz 2019



The name 'Grounded Cru' epitomises Joffa's philosophies. 'Grounded' reflects his down to earth nature and the fact that he values relationships (collaborating with growers, etc) and pays attention to the little things; handcrafting his wines. It also carries a link to terroir and the vineyard. 'Cru' is a French word meaning 'growth'. It is also used with terms 'Grand' and 'Premier' to classify the superior quality of a vineyard. Joffa also likes to think of 'Cru' with regards

to joining the crew or being part of a group of like-minded people. The Grounded Cru brand features handmade typography and a down to earth (grounded) Australian icon. We think this perfectly tells our unique story. In their relatively brief history, Grounded Cru has built a reputation of producing premium wines in two of Australia's great growing regions, McLaren Vale and the Adelaide Hills.

Tasting Notes

Confectured black berries, along with licorice on the nose. The palate is confected, nice and ripe black and blue fruits, the oak is well integrated and give a support to the fruit with subtle cedar and cinnamon, fuller bodied with long finish.

William Downie Thousand Candles Shiraz 2014



William Downie is a young business that has quickly developed a reputation as one of Australia's nest Pinot Noir producers. The winery is based in Gippsland in eastern

Victoria and also produces wine from vineyards in the Yarra Valley and Mornington Peninsula.

Tasting Notes

An intriguing wine, deep and complex with luscious dark red fruits and white pepper on the nose. The palate has a lovely, silky texture with blackberry, cinnamon and dry herbs. The fine tannins and bright acid gives this wine great length with a beautiful weight and drinkability.

Lou Miranda Estate 117yr Old Vine Shiraz Mourvedre 2015



Based at the Southern end of the Barossa Valley, South Australia. Great food and wine is best shared, this is our central philosophy at Lou Miranda Estate. Named for their father Lou Miranda, his daughters, Lisa, Angela and Victoria run the family boutique Barossa vineyards, winery and cellar door with charming devotion to good old-fashioned Italian hospitality.

All our wines are produced from our Estate owned vineyards, the 100 acres are on four sites located at a maximum of 8 kilometres from the winery. We are privileged to be custodians of four centenarian old vine blocks in Southern Barossa Valley, the oldest dating back to 1897. Our dedication to vineyard management is carried through from barrel to bottle.

Tasting Notes

A full bodied wine with abundant assertive tannin. A wine that is savoury in its profile. The rich concentrated palate weight is balanced by lingering tannins ensuring that the wine has amazing length and persistence on the palate.

Schubert Estate The Sentinel Barossa Valley Shiraz 2016



The pioneering Schubert Family planted vineyards in the Barossa Valley at their Roennfeldt Road estate in 1915. The fruit attracted strong interest from nearby wineries, admired for its quality and intense flavour. In 2000, a small parcel was retained yielding a single barrel of wine. Carrying the Schubert Estate name and the image of a goose, that wine represented the first step in a continuing journey. A pursuit of knowledge of

the world's best wine estates. A desire to uncover the building blocks of great wine. To inspire us to create 'First Growth' wines bold in character, and bearing the distinct flavour stamp of our estate vineyards in the Marananga sub region of the Barossa Valley. As a symbol of courage, strength and adventure, the goose sits proudly on the label of every wine we make. It guides each step of the journey we are on.

Tasting Notes

On the nose there are wafts of freshly roasted coffee, Christmas cake, black currant, dates and baking spices. The palate is rich with flavours of blackberry, black plums, cocoa powder and graphite partnered with fine grain cedar oak tannins and fresh acidity and alcohol warmth.

Blind Corner Bernard Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

Blind Corner was dreamt up by Ben & Naomi Gould in 2007. In 2009, they set to work on their small 4Ha vineyard making wild wines in the shed. Fast-forward 17 years and Blind Corner now sits on 20Ha of certified Organic & Biodynamic vineyard. Ben & Naomi continue to stick to their aim of working naturally within both the vineyard and winery, promoting transparency and minimising outside influences.

Blind Corner wines are made using grapes and native yeasts with no additions, other than sometimes a minimal amount of sulphur. The Pétillant, Shiraz, Fortified & Qvevri wines are all sans soufre (nothing added). This journey has caused them to become leaders within Australia in both regenerative farming and true natural winemaking.

Tasting Notes

Delightful aromas of clove, cherry, sultana, blackcurrant. Palate is rich, mouth-filling with grippy tannins and a complex fruit core set to unearth abundant richness for years to come.
