Heirloom Vineyards was conceived in vintage 2000, when a young winemaking student caught the eye of a silly old wine judge. A love story ensued inspired by two vows: To preserve the best of tradition, the old world of wine and our unique old vineyards and to champion the best clones of each variety

planted in the most appropriate sites embracing the principals of organic and biodynamic farming. Seven long vintages of trial and error passed before Heirloom Vineyards could make a wine that was fine enough to pass on to future generations. That is this wine.

Tasting Notes

The plush, generous fruit is brilliantly offset by plating tannins and a zippy acidity. All of these qualities crash together at the end of the palate. Notes of cherried fruits, puckering tannins, and piquant acidity.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of dark plum and ripe cherry, with dark chocolate, tobacco and charry toasted oak. Palate notes of deep currants and plum with mouth-coating tannins that match the intensity of the fruit and hold strong through the finish.

Terre à Terre Crayeres Vineyard Reserve 2016



Terre à Terre was established in 2008 by Xavier and Lucy Bizot. The winery is based in Piccadilly Valley (Adelaide Hills), while the vineyard is in Wrattobully. “Terre à Terre” means “Down to Earth” in French, and it is very much the philosophy of

Xavier and Lucy to not follow trends and fashions, but to have a very down to earth approach of trying to produce the best fruit from their well designed and established vineyards to make the best wine possible.

Tasting Notes

The bouquet shows dried balsamic herbs and touches of mint, cedar and tobacco, while the palate is sweetly raspberry, mulberry-like and showing more elegance than concentration or brute power.

Kangarilla Road Zinfandel 2019

Sourced from our Estate vineyard in the heart of McLaren Flat. It is located in the northern part of the foothills and ripens later than many of the other sub-regions resulting in an abundance of soft-velvety tannins. Fermented in

traditional oak vats, the wine will soak on grape skins to help build structure and mid-palate. After ferment, the wine was stored in one-year old French oak hogshead barrels for 18 months.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of blackcurrant, stewed rhubarb, hibiscus, bramble, eastern spice with glimpses of sweet dried raisin and violet. Rich, luscious palate with dense mulberry flavours enhanced by mixed spices and pepperberries. Great length.

Thorn Clarke Bona Fide Graciano Shiraz 2019



The Thorn-Clarke family are known as sixth generation wine region employees, establishing a winery to solidify their presence in the region. Wines are styled for premium consumption, with vineyards being paramount in the winemaking process. Grape growing is the primary activity, wine producing a by product of the years of experience with the vines. Thorn Clarke is a Barossa Valley based winery that sources fruit from premier vineyards in the Eden Valley

and Barossa Valley. The individual vineyard sites are Mount Crawford and Milton Park (Eden) and Kabinge and St Kitts (Barossa). Whites are left to Eden Valley, reds to Barossa Valley. Modern winemaking techniques are applied in their updated and modern winery. Technology assists in the production of cleanly made, volume brands that convey their regionality but ultimately are style for easy, early consumption.

Tasting Notes

Alluring nose of licorice, plum and perfume. Perfectly poised palate with mulberries, exotic herbs and savoury spice with velvety tannins supporting a long fine finish.
