



Nightfall 'Norma' Single Vineyard Shiraz 2021



A special project from Sam Brand, Nightfall wines are created to provide a feeling of luxury, style and exclusivity. An extremely limited series of wines, all sourced from single vineyard sites with a definitive sense of origin; a pure representation of the soil, the site and the stars. The concept for Nightfall was born after a dinner with customers,

winemaker Sam Brand, walked outside to find his clients all looking up, mesmerised by the clarity and beauty of the night sky above Coonawarra. Having never seen the stars so vividly, his guests stood in awe and likened the stars to diamonds in the sky. The uniqueness of this moment, an experience shared and always remembered was the inspiration for Nightfall.

Tasting Notes

Perfumed aromas of forest berries, vanilla, cinnamon and toasted mocha. The intense palate is balanced with ripe plum, raspberry and cherry. Powerfully integrated tannins and acid hold the fruit and structure over a long finish.

2018 Chateau Croix Mouton **Bordeaux Superieur**

Château Croix Mouton is positioned in the commune of Lugon, on the clay soils of 'lle de Carney'. The setting is bucolic with true rural charm, seeing the serene sun rising over the misty Dordogne river during the harvest period. Croix Mouton has 55 hectares of prime terroir consisting of 85% Merlot, 14% Cabernet Franc and 1% Petit Verdot with an average age of

vines at 37 years old. The resulting wines are Merlot-driven, full-bodied and rich in flavour, easy to drink but with finesse and a stunning display of fresh red fruit on the palate. The 'M' on Château Croix Mouton's label is special. It changes shape and colour each year to reflect the personality of each vintage.

Tasting Notes

The palate is ample and juicy, full of charming finesse. This wine is best appreciated when young, when its fruity bouquet shows all its liveliness.

2019 Greenock Creek **Special Bottling Shiraz Cabernet**



Greenock Creek wine is made in a time-honoured way that has endured four decades. Passed studiously from one winemaker to the next, ensuring consistency of the Greenock Creek house style, whilst enabling each new generation their opportunity to quietly evolve wine expression. Grapes are harvested at optimal ripeness, to create the rich, full-bodied, fruit-driven wines

with silken tannin that they are renowned for. Maturation in tight-grained oak barrels of varied age serves to elevate the flavour profile of each site. The wines are bottled when oak and fruit flavours are in harmonious balance, intended to be immediately enjoyable upon release, but also capable of ageing with grace for many years.

Tasting Notes

Rustic earthiness from the Cabernet acts as a counterpoint to vanillin oak, enhancing minty chocolate notes. Silky, mouthfilling tannins frame vibrant black fruit, leading to a long and lingering finish of sweet spice.

Pyren is located in an isolated patch of earth surrounded by state forest, farmland and the ever-changing sky. Planted in 1999, established by brothers Brian & Kevyn Joy, and currently operated day to day by Graeme Miles in the vineyard, and

Leighton Joy in the winery. The house style is to meld the expression of very high quality fruit with integrity and artistic freedom. The endeavour to fine tune the best style for Pyren's fruit is a continuous one that knows no bounds.

Tasting Notes

Nashi pear, green grape, hazelnut, soft profile but lush palate. Soft, silky smooth and lingers in the mouth with great life.

Tascante Buonora Etna Bianco 2021

Tasca d'Almerita's history in Sicily is written in the land for which they have cared for over eight generations. Since first plantings in 1830, Tasca d'Almerita have established five different estates in Sicily - Regaleali, Capofaro, Tascante, Whitaker and Sallier de La Tour - each with its own characteristics. The Tascante estate was established in 2007 with its vineyard on the highest volcano in Europe, Mount Etna. A force of nature in its primordial state. But truly

knowing the character of a land, understanding its nuances, identifying its strengths and other more problematic aspects, is never easy or immediate. It takes time to really understand the details. And details make all the difference. Autochthonous varieties of Nerello Mascalese and Carricante grapes interact magically with the volcanic soils of Mt. Etna, expressing the strength of the territory in a distinctive and unmistakable way.

Tasting Notes

Notes of lemongrass, citrus, green apple skins and hints of delicate stone fruits. Distinctive flavours like celery and dried mint emerge, complementing the volcanic minerality and tangy acidity.

Artis Single Vineyard Clare Valley Riesling 2022

Artis Wines was founded by Andrew Miller in 2016, making a Clare Valley Riesling and an Adelaide Hills Shiraz. "Artis" is Latin for craft and art, which he thought to be an appropriate name as he wanted to get back to the basics and craft interesting wines that, whilst distinctly Australian, were

a bit quirky and unique. The label is a collage of images representing the countries where he has worked, the snakes and ladders being a play on the various ups and downs experienced along the way.

Tasting Notes

Flinty notes coming through slightly, but the nose is quite restrained, maintaining mystery. The palate is really zinging, notes of lemongrass, a hint of ginger, flint, lime etc. A lot going on here!
