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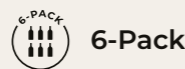
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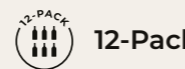

Domaine Les Capréoles Régnié Diaclase 2018

When Cédric Lecareux and his wife Catherine, native of Beaujolais, discovered the property, it was love at first sight. Located in Regnie-Durette, the wine estate, steeped in history for more than 250 years, charmed them with its old stones and

ancient arched cellars. With an existing winery and 3.5 hectares of old Gamay vines surrounding the house, everything was there for them to combine their wine project and family life. They took the plunge and made their first vintage in 2014.



Tasting Notes

This Régnié has such imposing stature and concentration. Black-cherry, plum and dry-earth aromas are wrapped around the substantial fine tannins on the richly textural palate. The lively mineral acidity keeps this abundance on track right the way to the end of the long finish.

Tasting Notes

Powerful and vibrant blackberry and ripe mulberry, with underlying notes of savoury roasted nuts and black olive. Persistent dark fruit, fine tannins and integrated subdued barrel characters deliver an intricate wine with intensity, elegance and graceful aging potential.

Tasting Notes

The colour has a lovely intense purple hue. The aromatics are delicate and floral with spice but the profound underlying terroir expression is of complex ripe strawberry puree and a hint of earth. It has moderate alcohol and finely textured structure. The flavours float on water not alcohol.

Schwarz 1968 Grenache 2020

This glorious grenache comes to us from Jason Schwarz, who has tapped into fruit from his parent's Bethany vineyard planted back in the 1940s. The proud style here is not your typical old school Barossan method either, with up to 25%

whole bunches added for spice and complexity, plus mature oak barrels to give weight and texture without overt oak characteristics.



Tasting Notes

Beautiful aromatics, red crunchy fruit, red boiled lollies with a dense brooding intensity, and decent amount of oak. It's bright, juicy, raspberried, yet with layers of meaty, chunky power that hints at old vines and very low yields.

Kangarilla Road Zinfandel 2019

Our love of wine and our curiosity for alternative varieties is what made McLaren Vale our home on Kevin's birthday in March 1997; the day we decided to purchase a site once known as the old Cambrai Vineyard. This was the beginning of our journey to Kangarilla Road. We were confident this was the site for us and the name 'Kangarilla Road' was a natural

fit. 'Kangarilla' is an aboriginal word from the local Kurna people, which describes a place where something is nurtured and is also thought to mean a place with abundant resources. The word 'Road' simply enough signified the journey we were embarking on. For us that journey begins by nurturing our vineyards.

Tasting Notes

Lovely aromas of blackcurrants, stewed rhubarb, hibiscus tea and wild brambles all entwined with exotic eastern spices. The palate is rich and luscious with dense mulberry flavours enhanced by mixed spices and pepperberries and these flavours last and last.
