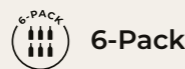

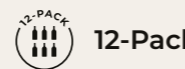

Nightfall 'Norma' Single Vineyard Shiraz 2021



A special project from Sam Brand, Nightfall wines are created to provide a feeling of luxury, style and exclusivity. An extremely limited series of wines, all sourced from single vineyard sites with a definitive sense of origin; a pure representation of the soil, the site and the stars. The concept for Nightfall was born after a dinner with customers,

winemaker Sam Brand, walked outside to find his clients all looking up, mesmerised by the clarity and beauty of the night sky above Coonawarra. Having never seen the stars so vividly, his guests stood in awe and likened the stars to diamonds in the sky. The uniqueness of this moment, an experience shared and always remembered was the inspiration for Nightfall.

Tasting Notes

Perfumed aromas of forest berries, vanilla, cinnamon and toasted mocha. The intense palate is balanced with ripe plum, raspberry and cherry. Powerfully integrated tannins and acid hold the fruit and structure over a long finish.

2018 Chateau Croix Mouton Bordeaux Superieur

Château Croix Mouton is positioned in the commune of Lugon, on the clay soils of 'Ile de Carney'. The setting is bucolic with true rural charm, seeing the serene sun rising over the misty Dordogne river during the harvest period. Croix Mouton has 55 hectares of prime terroir consisting of 85% Merlot, 14% Cabernet Franc and 1% Petit Verdot with an average age of

vines at 37 years old. The resulting wines are Merlot-driven, full-bodied and rich in flavour, easy to drink but with finesse and a stunning display of fresh red fruit on the palate. The 'M' on Château Croix Mouton's label is special. It changes shape and colour each year to reflect the personality of each vintage.

Tasting Notes

The palate is ample and juicy, full of charming finesse. This wine is best appreciated when young, when its fruity bouquet shows all its liveliness.

2019 Greenock Creek Special Bottling Shiraz Cabernet



Greenock Creek wine is made in a time-honoured way that has endured four decades. Passed studiously from one winemaker to the next, ensuring consistency of the Greenock Creek house style, whilst enabling each new generation their opportunity to quietly evolve wine expression. Grapes are harvested at optimal ripeness, to create the rich, full-bodied, fruit-driven wines

with silken tannin that they are renowned for. Maturation in tight-grained oak barrels of varied age serves to elevate the flavour profile of each site. The wines are bottled when oak and fruit flavours are in harmonious balance, intended to be immediately enjoyable upon release, but also capable of ageing with grace for many years.

Tasting Notes

Rustic earthiness from the Cabernet acts as a counterpoint to vanillin oak, enhancing minty chocolate notes. Silky, mouthfilling tannins frame vibrant black fruit, leading to a long and lingering finish of sweet spice.

Levantine Hill is the perfect merger of two vineyards right in the heart of the Yarra Valley. On the one

Tasting Notes

Wonderfully expressive aromas of mulled strawberry, forest floor and clove. Plush and refined palate, red berries and velvet umami throughout, savoury, earthy characters and a stalkiness giving the wine structure.

Castelli del Grevepesa Chianti Classico Riserva DOCG 2019

The 1960s were difficult years for the Chianti Classico: an economic and technical crisis hit Chianti winegrowing, which was still stuck using old production methods. It was the visionary Sir Armando Nunzi who finally managed to persuade a group of winegrowers to get on board with the innovative idea of founding a modern cooperative winery capable of harvesting and producing wine from the grapes of future partners. Thus it was that on 21 June 1965, Sir Gualtiero Armando Nunzi,

together with his initial group of 17 winegrowers, united under the name of Castelli del Grevepesa. The shared intention was to bring together various winegrowers from the different areas of Florentine Chianti Classico, in order to safeguard the land and maintain intact the age-old traditions of Tuscan winegrowing; the long-established know-how that farmers still today pass on from one generation to the next. Over 50 years later, Castelli del Grevepesa today has over 120 associate winegrowers.

Tasting Notes

Wine produced mainly from Sangiovese grapes, with a very intense ruby red colour. Complex and elegant bouquet with notes of ripe fruit and tertiary aromas including vanilla. Wine with a soft and balanced flavour and a persistent finish.
