



2011 Two Vintners Merlot – Columbia Valley

90% Merlot 5% Cabernet Franc 5% Petit Verdot

Tasting Notes: Big and brawny this wine challenges the notion that Merlot should play second fiddle to Cabernet. Amazing red fruits mixed with great tannic structure make this a wine that begs for a big piece of red meat.

Vineyard

Stillwater Creek – Merlot – Planted in 2000 this 235 acre site is located in the Royal Slope area of the Columbia Valley . 68%

Kiona Vineyard–Merlot– 22% – Founded in 1975, Kiona was the first vineyard on Red Mountain. Kiona has a long history of producing powerful well structured fruit.

Seven Hills Vineyard – Cabernet Franc – A world famous Walla Walla vineyard first planted in 1980 and now covering over 200 acres.

Kiona Vineyard – Petit Verdot – Founded in 1975, Kiona was the first vineyard on Red Mountain. Kiona has a long history of producing powerful well structured fruit.

Winemaking– Destemmed then fermented in open top bins and punched down 3 times daily. Aged in 50% new French Oak for 22 months.
