



2012 Two Vintners Lola – Walla Walla Valley

60% Syrah 40% Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes – Big bold red fruit backed up by the firm tannins one comes to expect from Lola, with some savory flavors from the Syrah this wine is always a crowd pleaser.

Vineyards

Yellow Jacket Vineyard – Walla Walla AVA – Syrah – Planted by Tom Waliser in the famous Milton–Freewater cobblestones in 1999 and covers 7.5 acres.

Pepper Bridge Vineyard – Walla Walla AVA – Cabernet Sauvignon – First planted in 1991 by Norm McKibben, PepperBridge Vineyard is one of Walla Walla’s most iconic vineyards. A cool site, Pepper Bridge produces dark muscular fruit with substantial structure.

Klipsun Vineyard – Red Mountain– Cabernet Sauvignon– Founded in 1982 by Patricia and David Gelles on the southwest slope of Red Mountain, named one of the Top 25 Vineyards in the World by Wine & Spirits magazine

Winemaking–. Fermented in open top bins and punched down 3 times daily for 10–14 days, then aged in French Oak for 18 months.

Only 170 cases produced.
