Red Mountain – Klipsun Vineyard 34%

Walla Walla (Rocks) – Stoney Vine Vineyard 22%

Horse Heaven Hills – Discovery Vineyard 19%

Yakima Valley – Olsen Vineyard 19%

Wahluke Slope – StonTree Vineyard 6%

Winemaking– All the grapes were fermented with native yeast and 30% whole cluster. The Olsen Syrah was co fermented with 10% whole cluster Roussanne. Aged for 18 months in 15% new oak by way of 500lt puncheon 85% neutral in 225lt barrels
