Vineyards

Boushey Vineyard – Grenache Blanc – An iconic Washington grower Dick Boushey has been at the forefront of the Washington wine scene since he planted his 160 acre vineyard in 1980.

Olsen Vineyard – Roussanne – First planted in 1979 Olsen vineyard is one of the premier growers in the state and now encompass over 800 acres in the Yakima Valley

Winemaking- the Grenache Blanc was gently pressed whole cluster, one third barrel fermented and the remaining two thirds cold fermented in stainless steel. The barrel fermented portion was left on the lees and stirred weekly for 6 months. The Roussanne was gently pressed off and cold fermented in stainless steel and stored on the lees in stainless steel barrels until bottling.
