



2013 Two Vintners OG – Olsen Vineyard

100% Gewürztraminer

Tasty Notes – Have you ever wanted to venture off the beaten path and try something new and unheard of? This is that wine, uncontrollable floral and citrus aromatics practically jump out of a glass of this wine. While the nose screams sugar the palate will pleasantly surprise you with a dry finish, rounded off by a beautiful orange color this wine is sure to turn heads wherever it is served.

Vineyards – Olsen Vineyard Yakima Valley Washington – The Olsen family began growing grapes in 1979 and now have over 800 acres of grapes in the southeast corner of the Yakima AVA. One of the premier Washington vineyards Olsen consistently produces outstanding fruit.

Winemaking– After the select harvest of the most sun-exposed clusters was delivered to winery the grapes were then destemmed and put into a stainless steel tank for fermentation. Fermented cold over 4.5 weeks and then gently pressed off the skins. The wine was then aged on the lees in neutral French oak for 10 months with weekly stirrings of the lees. No malo-lactic fermentation.

Alcohol – 14.3%
