



2014 Two Vintners Lola – Walla Walla Valley **70% Syrah 30% Cabernet Sauvignon**

Tasting Notes – Friendly, attention seeking and slightly funky smelling, just like her namesake (the winery dog) this wine is always a crowd pleaser. With big Cabernet fruits swirled with funky Walla Walla Rock’s Syrah how could a person say no?

Vineyards

Yellow Jacket Vineyard - Walla Walla AVA - Syrah - Planted by Tom Waliser in the famous Milton-Freewater cobblestones in 2001 and covers 7.5 acres.

Pepper Bridge Vineyard - Walla Walla AVA –Cabernet Sauvignon - First planted in 1991 by Norm McKibben, PepperBridge Vineyard is one of Walla Walla’s most iconic vineyards. A cool site, Pepper Bridge produces dark muscular fruit with substantial structure.

Stoney Vine Vineyard – Walla Walla AVA – Syrah – Right down the street from Yellow Jacket Vineyard, similar soil composition but without cover crop. Planted in 2007 by Dusted Valley winery.

Winemaking- Fermented in open top bins and punched down 3 times daily for 10-14 days, then aged in French Oak for 18 months.

225 cases produced- Released February 2017.
