



## 2014 Two Vintners – Stones Syrah

**Tasting Notes** – Wild aromatics leap out of a glass of this wine, smoky earthy meatiness dominates with just enough fruit to balance, this wine coats the palate and leaves you wanting more.

*95pts Wine Spectator (2013) - Supple and expressive, this is layered with plum, rose petal, orange peel and bacon flavors that come together harmoniously and extend into a long and harmonious finish. Shows great presence and depth.*

**Vineyard** – Stoney Vine Vineyard was planted in 2007 and lies on the Oregon side of the Walla Walla Valley, located just outside of Milton Freewater in the now famous “Rocks” region of Walla Walla. The 17 acre vineyard sits atop an alluvial fan comprised of rounded basalt river cobble formed by the ancient bed of the Walla Walla River.

**Winemaking**- The grapes were fermented with native yeast and 50% whole cluster fruit and punched down three times daily. It was then aged for 18 months in 88% neutral French oak and 12% in a new French oak Puncheon.
