2014 Two Vintners Make Haste – Olsen Vineyard **100% Cinsault**

Tasty Notes – Just one look at the label tells you that this will be one fun wine. There isn't much Cinsault planted in Washington State, and we're lucky to be getting some from the esteemed Olsen Vineyard in the Yakima Valley.

90pts Wine Enthusiast – *“Vibrant aromas of violets, potpourri, red fruit, orange peel and plum are followed by mesmerizingly pure fruit and savory flavors that linger on a long finish”*

Vineyards – Olsen Vineyard Yakima Valley Washington – The Olsen family began growing grapes in 1979 and now have over 800 acres of grapes in the southeast corner of the Yakima AVA. One of the premier Washington vineyards Olsen consistently produces outstanding fruit.

Winemaking- Fermented 30% whole cluster with native yeasts. Fermentation was done in open top 1 ton fermenters with punchdowns done 2/3 times daily until dry. Aged for 18 months in neutral French oak barriques.

Alcohol - 15.3%
