



2015 Two Vintners - Diamonds Syrah

Tasting Notes – With a subtle backbone of acidity this wine showcases the savory minerality we've come to expect from Discovery vineyard along with bright meaty & floral flavors. Washington Syrah at its finest.

Vineyard – On the south edge of the Horse Heaven Hill AVA, this site overlooks the Columbia River and Oregon to the south. Planted in 2005 by Kay & Milo May with Paul Champoux consulting this cool site produces grapes with a great balance of acidity and ripeness.

Winemaking- The grapes were fermented with native yeast and 50% whole cluster fruit and punched down three times daily. It was then aged for 18 months in 88% neutral French oak and 12% in a new French oak Puncheon.
