



2016 Two Vintners Grenache Blanc – Boushey Vineyard 75% Grenache Blanc 25% Roussanne

Tasty Notes – A gorgeous white that will win you over with expressive citrus, melon and floral notes with vivid stone fruit on the palate backed by lean acidity.

91 pts Wine Enthusiast – *“Blended with 25% Roussanne, this wine brings light aromas of straw, lees and spice. The palate is medium bodied, with tart lemony acidity followed by a lingering finish. It's perhaps the best example of this variety from the state to date.”*

Vineyards

Boushey Vineyard – Grenache Blanc - An iconic Washington grower Dick Boushey has been at the forefront of the Washington wine scene since he planted his 160 acre vineyard in 1980.

Olsen Vineyard – Roussanne - First planted in 1979 Olsen vineyard is one of the premier growers in the state and now encompass over 800 acres in the Yakima Valley

Winemaking- the Grenache Blanc was gently pressed whole cluster, two third barrel fermented and the remaining one third cold fermented in stainless steel. The barrel fermented portion was about 15% new oak. Left on the lees and stirred weekly for 6 months. The Roussanne was gently pressed off and cold fermented in stainless steel and stored on the lees in stainless steel barrels until bottling.
