Vineyards

Boushey Vineyard – Grenache Blanc - An iconic Washington grower Dick Boushey has been at the forefront of the Washington wine scene since he planted his 160 acre vineyard in 1980.

Olsen Vineyard – Roussanne - First planted in 1979 Olsen vineyard is one of the premier growers in the state and now encompass over 800 acres in the Yakima Valley

Winemaking- The Grenache Blanc was gently pressed whole cluster, with 75% barrel fermented and the remaining one 25% cold fermented in stainless steel. The barrel fermented portion was approximately 15% new oak. Left on the lees and with periodic battonage for 5 months. The Roussanne was gently pressed off and cold fermented in stainless steel and stored on the lees in stainless steel barrels until bottling.
