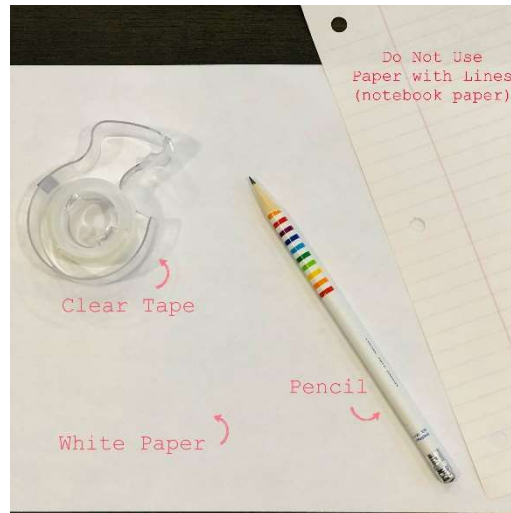

How to capture a fingerprint for engraving.



You'll Need:

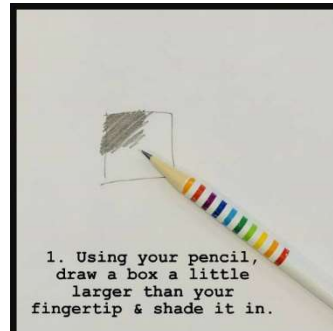
- ❖ White Paper
- ❖ A Pencil
- ❖ Clear Tape



YOU'LL NEED

- ❖ White Paper
- ❖ A Pencil
- ❖ Clear Tape
- ❖ Your Finger

1. Using the pencil, draw a box a little larger than your fingertip & shade it in.



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2. Shade the box until little white can be seen. This will be your "ink pad".



2. Shade the box until very little white can be seen. This will become your "ink pad".

3. Rub your finger back & forth across the "ink pad". Repeat several times.

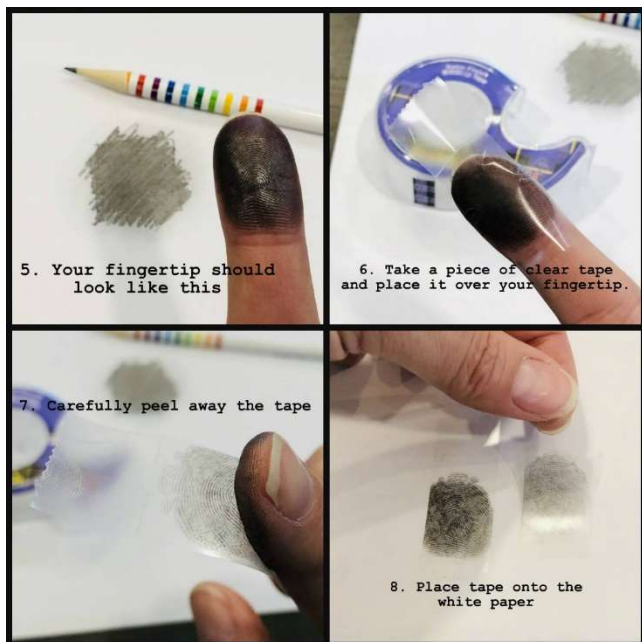
4. Be sure to get the top and sides of your finger

4. Be sure to cover the top and sides of your finger

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5. Your fingertip should be thoroughly coated in pencil shading.
6. Place a strip of clear tape over your fingertip, pressing down to ensure the tape touches your entire fingertip.
7. Carefully peel away the tape.
8. Attach the tape to your white paper.

Use a smartphone to capture a black & white image of your fingerprint.

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
