



CUPCAKE PLACEMAT



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Finished Size : 10 ½"x 17"

MATERIALS:

• small amount of fabrics from LIBERTY -



Tea for Two fabric range Flowertops 04775618X



Tea Party 04775617X



Heart Bouquet 04775623X



Garden Trail 04775619X



Candy Hearts 04775621X

Teacup Treasures 04775620X 2 x 2" strips

• Leutenegger Cotton Chambray

Sunshine HCM004 - 10" strip

- DMC Cotton 603 light pink
- 10 ½"x 17"piece of batting
- small amount of fusible web

The fabric requirements is for making placemat as shown in the photograph. Before cutting review the placement of colours in case you want to make you own choices.



CUTTING

Cut 1 piece of Cotton Chambray Sunshine 10½"x 17" for placemat back.

Cut 1 piece of Candy Hearts - 10¹/₂" x 8¹/₂"

Cut 12 squares from selected fabrics - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

Stitch squares together with ¼" seam allowance. Refer to the photo for placement or make your own choices.

Trace the appliqué design pieces from the template onto the paper side of fusible webbing. Cut out the pieces roughly leaving about 1/4" of webbing around the tracing lines.

Place the fusible webbing pieces onto the wrong side of chosen fabric, then fuse for a few seconds with a dry iron.

CUPCAKE PLACEMAT

Cut out appliqué piece neatly on the lines. Peel off paper backing, then position appliqué pieces on project (webbing side down), layering the pieces as indicated on the placement guide. When happy with the arrangement, place a press cloth over the design, then fuse in place with an iron.

Using two strands of DMC cotton 603 work Blanket stitch around the edges and Running stitch on the cupcake base.





With wrong sides facing, layer placemat's top and backing, with batting in-between (quilt sandwich). Smooth out all creases. Quilt as desired.

BINDING

Sew 2" binding strips together end-to-end using diagonal seams.

Sew the binding onto the placemat's front first. Pin the binding to a side of the placemat approximately 4"- 5" away from the corner. Start stitching binding strip with 1/4" seam allowance, leaving an approximated 3" tail.



Keep sewing until you reach a corner, and stop stitching and backstitch 1/4" before the corner. Remove the placemat from under the machine foot. Fold the strip in a motion of 45° and upward, pressing

with your fingers.

Hold this fold with your finger, bring the strip down in line with the next edge, making a horizontal fold that aligns with the top edge of the placemat.

Start sewing at 1/4" of the border, stitching all the layers. Do the same in the four corners.



Stop stitching before you reach the last 3 - 4''. Remove the quilt from under the machine presser foot. Lay the loose ends of the binding flat along the edge, folding the ends back on themselves where they meet. Press them together to form a crease. Using this crease as the stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding with right sides together.

Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press open. Complete the sewing.

Turn binding to back of the placemat and hand stitch it in place.

Enjoy your new creation!
