FLORAL CUSHION



DMC PEARL COTTON

ELEPHANT CUSHION

33 x 25cm

MATERIALS:

- Linen Cushion item code SPG0002 – available through one duck two stockists
- DMC Cotton Pearl 5
BLANC - 2 skein2
- DMC Embroidery Needle 1765.3
- DMC Water soluble marking pencil S1500

TO BEGIN:

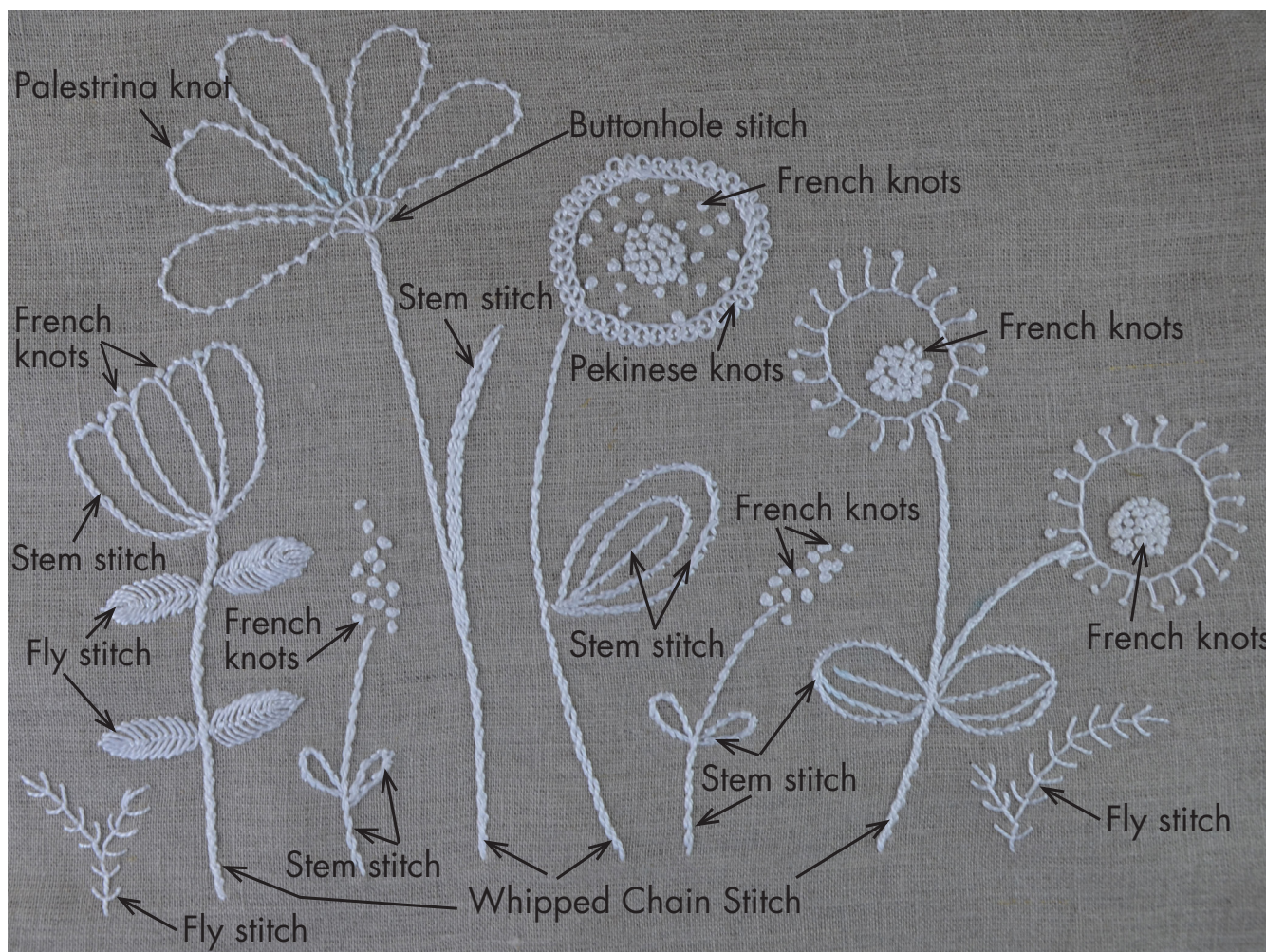
1. Start by finding the centre of the cushion, fold it into quarters to make a crease - this will show you the middle.

2. Print out pages with design outlines and join them together on the centre arrows. Trace outlines with DMC Water soluble marking pencil.

3. Embroider stems and flowers using required stitch types.

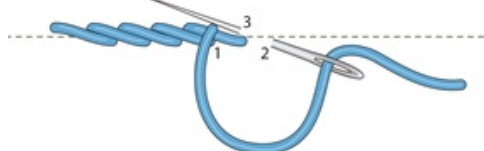
NOTE: When stitching, make sure you don't pull the thread too tight as this can make the work uneven. To end off your thread, take your needle through to the back of your work and run it under a few stitches then trim cleanly.

4. Once you have completed all the stitching, iron it flat from the back with an iron on warm using a cloth to protect your stitching.

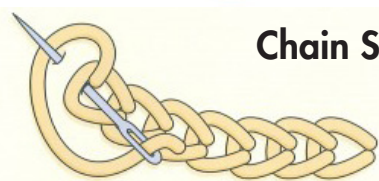

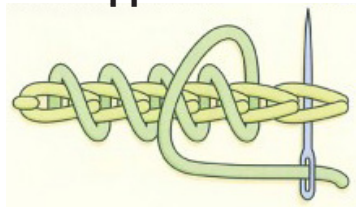
Stem Stitch



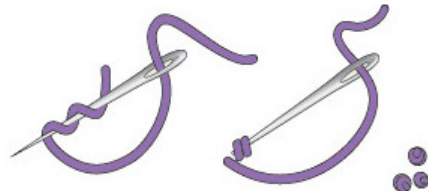
Chain Stitch



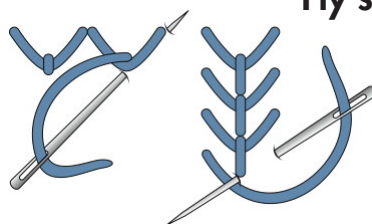
Whipped Chain Stitch



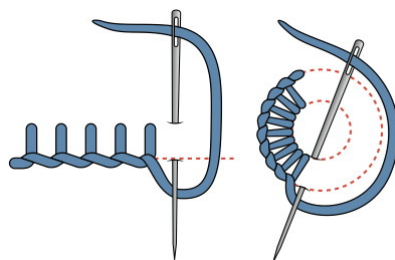
French knot



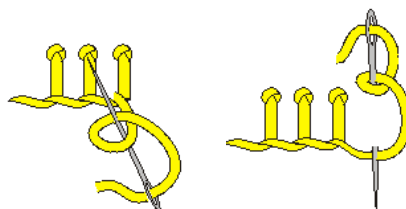
Fly stitch



Buttonhole stitch



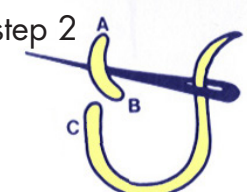
Knotted buttonhole stitch



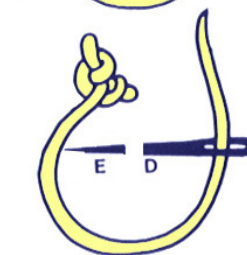

Palestrina knot

To begin bring your needle up at 1 and then insert your needle at a slant at 2 and bring it up again at 3. Pull through to form a vertical straight stitch. See step 1.

Next insert your needle up and under the straight stitch you just created, do not pierce the fabric. Pull through gently. See step 2. Insert your needle through your straight stitch again. Don't pierce the fabric. Pull through. See step 3.

To work your next stitch insert your needle approx. 5mm below your first knot and take a small slanted stitch as in step 1. Work the stitch as you did the previous one.

Pekinese Stitch

First work a foundation row of Back stitch. See step 1.

Pull out the threaded needle through the outer corner of the first back stitch.

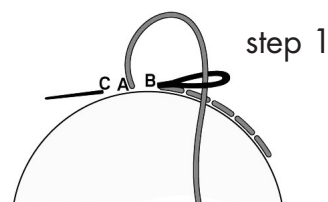
Wrap the thread around the joint of two back stitches without poking the fabric. See step 2. Do not pull the thread too much.

Pull the threaded needle and wrap the next joint. See step 3.

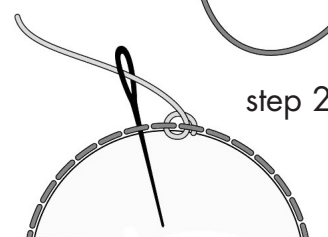
Continue the process till the last joint.

At the end poke the needle in through the outer corner of the last back stitch.

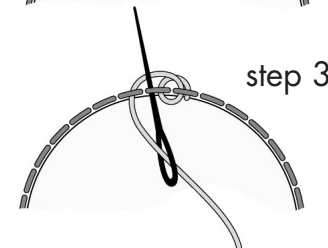

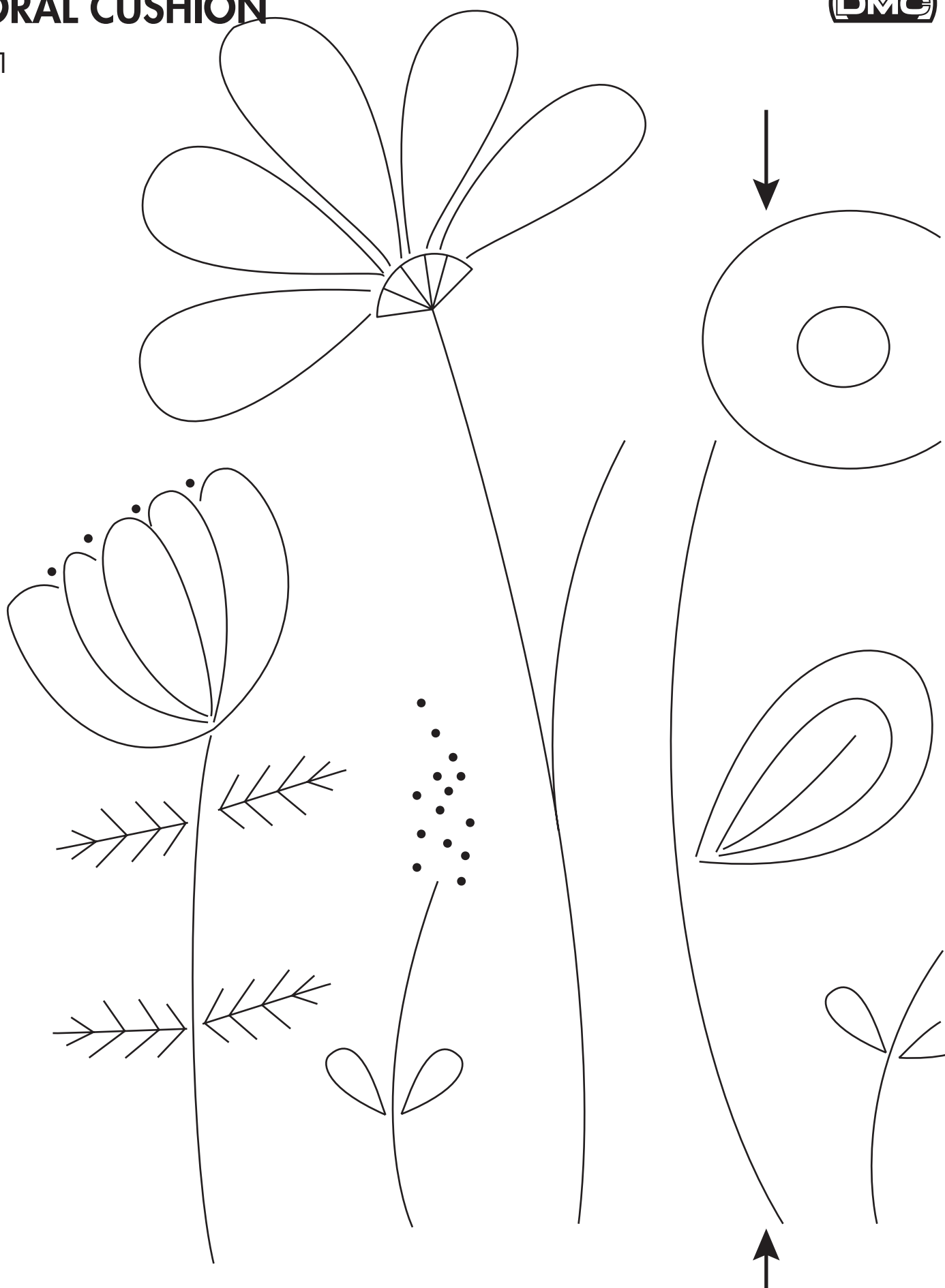
