



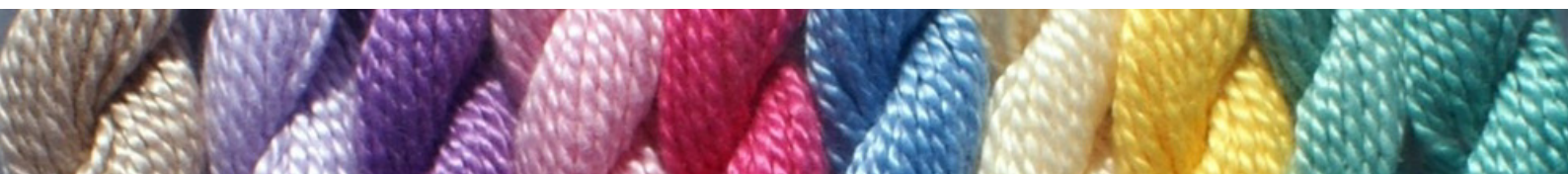

## BEAD NECKLACE

### MATERIALS:

- Hook – 1.5-2mm
- Stitch Markers
- DMC PERLE 3 - 2 skeins of each
  - A – Yellow - 743
  - B – DK Yellow - 742
  - C – Rust Red - 498
- Fibre Fill
- Waxed cord or leather cord – easily sourced from BEADS I LOVE YOU

### Abbreviations – Crochet terms

Written in UK Terms

dc – double crochet

2dctog – decrease – double crochet two stitches together

ss – slip stitch

ch – chain

When working amigurumi style, remember to never turn your work – ALWAYS mark your first stitch of the row as you will be working in a spiral, and finding the beginning of your work can be problematic.

### LARGE BEAD

Commence with a magic circle

Round 1: 1dc 1ch (does not count as a stitch) 10 into circle

Round 2: Mark your first stitch 2 dc into each stitch around to end 20dc

Round 3: Mark your first stitch \*2 dc into next, 1dc into next repeat from \*to end around 30dc

Round 4: Mark your first stitch dc in each and every stitch to end 30dc

Round 5-11: repeat round 4

Round 12: Mark your first stitch, \*2dctog in next two stitches, dc in next stitch, repeat from \* to end around 20dc

Fibre fill your bead at this point

Round 13 mark your first stitch – 2dctog the remaining stitches, 10dc

Fill the remainder of the bead with fibre to make as firm as possible. Fibre fill your bead at this point – sew the opening closed

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### DISC

Round 1: 1dc 1ch (does not count as a stitch) 10 into circle

Round 2: Mark your first stitch 2 dc into each stitch around to end 20dc

Round 3: Mark your first stitch \*2 dc into next, 1dc into next repeat from \*to end around 30dc

Round 4: Mark your first stitch dc in each and every stitch to end fasten off 30dc

### MAKE

- two light yellow beads
- three darker yellow beads
- ten red discs

### CONSTRUCTION

Simply thread discs and beads on waxed cord, formation is simple

2 discs – dk yellow bead – 1 disc – light yellow bead – 2 discs – dark yellow bead – 2 disc – light yellow bead – 1 disc – dark yellow bead – 2 disc

Thread using a long doll makers needle or darning needle, knot at either end of discs – adjust length of cord to suit – simply tie around neck.
